

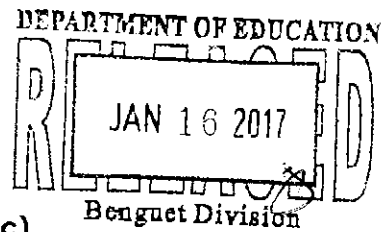

2017 METROBANK-MTAP DEPED MATH CHALLENGE



To: **Public Schools District Supervisors
Elementary and Secondary School Heads (Private & Public)
Teachers**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 141 s, 2015 and the letter of invitation to the schools division superintendent, the Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), the Mathematics Teachers of the Philippines (MTAP) and the Department of Education (DepEd) will hold the 2017 Metrobank-MTAP-DepED Math challenge from February to April 2017.
2. The overall objective of the competition is to contribute to the improvement of the quality of Mathematics Education in the Philippines through the following:
 - a. awakening greater interest in Mathematics among elementary and high school students in both public and private schools all over the country;
 - b. encouraging them to strive for excellence for Mathematics;
 - c. encouraging mastery of basic Mathematics skills;
 - d. discovering mathematical talents among the pupils/students;
 - e. developing the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty, teamwork, and sportsmanship; and
 - f. providing students with opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.
3. The elimination and district/division level competition will be participated in by all elementary school pupils (Private & Public) on February 16, 2017 for elementary and confirm your participation to the **District Math Coordinators** on or before January 30, 2017.
4. All secondary students (Private and Public) will participate in the division level competition in two different clusters on the dates follows.

February 17, 2016	Cluster II	La Trinidad, Atok, Kapangan, Kibungan, Tublay, Sablan, Itogon, Tuba, Bokod, & Bakun	Benguet NHS & Cordillera RSHS

Note: only those who submitted registration form (MMC Form No. 1) will qualify to join the elimination round. **Submission of registration form will on or before January 30, 2017 at the division office.**

5. Three students per grade/year level shall represent each school, for both public and private (Elementary and secondary), in the elimination round and registration start at 8:00 to 8:30 AM at the designated venues.
6. All district supervisors/mathematics coordinator will submit the number of participating schools per grade level on or before February 3, 2017 at the division office.
7. The contest mechanics/guidelines and Forms of the competition are contained in the enclosures.
8. Result of the elimination round per district will be submitted on or before February 22, 2017.
9. The highest two scorer per grade/year level will be reported. (See attached format)
10. Registration fee of Twenty Five (PHP25.00) per participants will be collected to defray expenses for meals & snacks of proctors, certificates and other expenses.
11. Travel expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local funds or PTA funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
12. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is requested.
