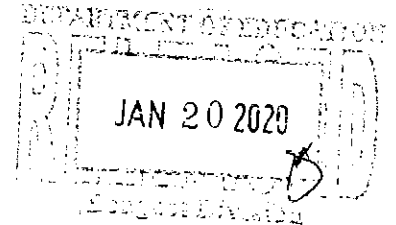

Subject: **ECHO TRAINING ON THE UNIVERSAL PREVENTION CURRICULA (UPC) FOR SUBSTANCE USE: CURRICULUM 1 and 2 - Introduction to Prevention Science, Physiology and Pharmacology for the District of Tublay, Benguet**

Date: **January 17, 2020**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) – Benguet Schools Division through the School Health Section will conduct a two-day *Echo Training on the Universal Prevention Curricula for Substance Use: Curriculum 1 and 2* as pilot program for the District of Tublay on January 28 - 29, 2020 at TSHI - Main, Acop, Caponga, Tublay, Benguet.
2. The Training aims to Orient and Capacitate the participants by:
 - a) Providing all participants, regardless of gender, with an overview of science that is the foundation for prevention;
 - b) providing all participants with an understanding of the physiology of addiction and pharmacology of psychoactive substance;
 - c) provide participants with the tools to inform stakeholders and policy-makers about the foundation of evidence-based substance use prevention.
