

## COLLECTION OF RELEVANT LOCAL STORIES AND WRITE-UP OF THE HISTORY OF SCHOOLS

- 1. The Benguet Provincial Library is undertaking a current project to conserve and protect the important recorded history and cultural heritage of Benguet Province. This includes the collections of the history of the different schools which the library intends to compile as one of the resources to be shared to the academe and the public.
- 2. The said project coincides with the ongoing initiative of SDO Benguet to collect the documented history of the early schools in the province and finalize the compilations of relevant local stories in support of the project of DepEd-CAR to compile local literature including local heroes under its Volume II Resource Book, titled IGABAY. The target compilations will serve as important learning resources for the contextualization of the curriculum.
- 3. Given the significance of the foregoing endeavors, all public schools are enjoined to come up with or update their respective school history and share other relevant local stories to be considered for compilations. - 4. To give time for review and editing by the Division Academic Review Board, write-ups and documentation shall be submitted on or before March 22, 2024.
