Subject: SDO - BENGUET'S RESPONSE TO THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS OR 2019-nCoV

Date: FEBRUARY 05, 2020

1. Pursuant to the directive of the President and DM 15, s. 2020, and in consideration of current government efforts to contain the 2019-nCoV ARD, the Schools Division of Benguet enforces the measures for the prevention and control of the 2019-nCoV in Basic Education Schools and Offices.


#### 2. The following measures shall be observed for DepEd activities for the month of February 2020:

- a. Travel limitations and restrictions.
  - i. Official travel of all DepEd personnel and learners previously approved to the People's Republic of China and its special administrative regions are temporarily banned.
  - ii. Personnel and learners coming from travel abroad shall comply with the 14-day prescribed quarantine procedures of proper government authorities before returning to work/school.
- b. Conduct of division and school activities.
  - i. All division and district events involving the learners and/or teachers requiring travel and congregation this month of February are suspended or postponed until further notice.
  - ii. All off-campus activities defined in DO no. 66, s. 2017 are suspended.
- c. Public information and awareness campaigns. School health personnel shall lead the information campaign to the district and schools. Attached is the Enclosure No. 5 and 7 of DM 15, s.2020.
- d. Close monitoring, appropriate management and referral of the health status of personnel and learners presenting respiratory infection by the school health personnel and/or clinic teacher using the attached referral form. (Enclosure No. 8 of DM 15, s.2020)
- e. PSDS, Secondary School heads with close participation of school health personnel shall submit every Monday of the week to the SDO School Health Section a health situation report from the schools using the attached template. (Enclosure No. 9 of DM 15, s.2020)
- 3. Attached to this memo are: Enclosure no. 5, 7, 8, 9, of DepEd Memoranda 15, s.2020.

#### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND PROTOCOLS<sup>2</sup>

#### 1. General Precautions

- a. DepEd reiterates its earlier directives for the strict observance of precautions recommended by DOH and WHO to reduce the general risk of transmission of respiratory infection, specifically, proper hand and respiratory hygiene, and safe food practices. Proper hand hygiene is needed to minimize the risk of transmission through touching any contaminated object, material or surface; the respiratory hygiene is needed to reduce the risk of spreading the virus by an infected individual; and the safe food practices is to reduce risk of exposure to or ingestion of contaminated food.
- b. The following proper hand and respiratory hygiene, and safe food practices, and related precautions are enjoined:
  - i. Frequently clean hands by using alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water;
  - ii. When coughing and sneezing, maintain distance and cover mouth and nose with flexed elbow or tissue throw tissue away into a closed bin immediately and wash hands;
  - iii. Avoid close contact with anyone who has fever and cough;
  - iv. If you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical care early and share previous travel history with your health care provider;
  - v. When visiting live markets in areas currently experiencing cases of novel coronavirus, avoid direct unprotected contact with live animals and surfaces in contact with animals;
  - vi. The consumption of raw or undercooked animal products should be avoided. Raw meat, milk or animal organs should be handled with care, to avoid cross-contamination with uncooked foods, as per good food safety practices; and
  - vii. Within healthcare facilities, enhance standard infection prevention and control practices in hospitals, especially in emergency departments.
- Airflow in classrooms should be improved by opening windows and doors as much as possible.

#### 2. When Respiratory Symptoms Occur

Wearing of medical mask is indicated for an individual exhibiting or feeling symptoms of respiratory infections. The medical mask is intended to contain respiratory secretions. Thus, it should be worn as much as possible. The
