

#### 2022 BENGUET PROVINCIAL VIRTUAL SPORTS SKILLS CONTEST

- In compliance with the constitutional mandate on promoting sports in education, and in adherence with the DepEd Sports Manual requiring each school to implement a minimum of three sports discipline per school; and, with strict compliance to health protocols in the locality; the 2022 Benguet Provincial Virtual Sports Skills Contest will be conducted this month of March and April.
- 2. The activity aims to provide opportunity for athletes and coaches a continuous development through the promotion of sports as a tool in fostering self-discipline, teamwork, friendship, sportsmanship, excellence, and other values inherent in the practice of sports. It is also an avenue of selecting players to represent the province in higher meets.
- 3. Participants to this activity are the currently enrolled learners from private and public school boys and girls elementary born not earlier than January 1, 2010. Over age elementary can compete in the secondary level. And secondary boys and girls born not earlier than January 1, 2004. They must be physically fit and are permitted by their parents/guardians.
- 4. The sports events to be contested are the following: Arnis elementary and secondary, athletics elementary and secondary, basketball elementary and secondary, billiards secondary only, boxing elementary and secondary, chess elementary and secondary, gymnastics elementary and secondary, sepak takraw elementary and secondary, taekwondo elementary and secondary and wushu secondary only.
- 5. Mechanics of the competition were discussed during the orientation of coaches on January 7, 2022, and on February 16, 2022. However, competition guidelines per sports event were attached. Contact numbers of the project proponents who were designated as tournament managers were written on the said guidelines for queries.

- 6. All contested events are done virtually except chess and basketball which will be competed face to face. Maximum time of actual sports skills performance to be video recorded is three (3) minutes. A maximum of 1.5 minutes is allowed for preparatory presentations or introductory portion e. g. name of player, school, sponsor, why did you join the competition etc. The performance should be accompanied by appropriate music and could also be with tarpaulin backdrop at the expense of the team. The camera must be stationed fix viewing all the performers.
- 7. Appropriate sports attires must be worn during the performance preferably uniforms. All video recorded entries will be directly submitted to the division technical officials care of the tournament managers. See attached names of tournament managers and calendar of activities.
- 8. The video recording must not be edited; allowed maximum pixel is 1000. Edited video recording will be automatically disqualified.
- 9. Teacher participants and other DepEd personnel are entitled for service credits/COC for attendances on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays in connection with these sports activities e. g. training, tune up, video recording and other related activities with the close supervision their immediate heads. Documents needed for the above attachment (F48, certificate of appearance) must be submitted on or before May 6, 2022, to this office care of the Division Sports Coordinator, duly signed by the tournament mangers.
- 10. First, second and third place winners will be awarded with medals and certificates charged to SEF. All other winners are finalist.
- 11. Expenses incurred by the participants in connection with this activity shall be personal and or charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
- 12. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memo is urged.
