

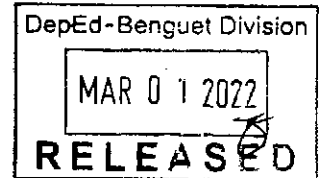

2022 NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION AND LAUNCHING OF 2022 GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES/LAVENDER (LaVishing Equity... Nurturing a GenDER lends)

- (1) R.A. 9710 known as Magna Carta for Women mandates the conduct of Gender Mainstreaming or strategies for making women's as well as men's concerns and experiences an integral dimension of the design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of policies, programs and projects in all social, political, civil and economic spheres. Further, the Philippine Commission on Women Gender and Development activities aims to inform and engage women as pioneers and beneficiaries of government programs and services – to promote citizen-centric governance and make "change" a conscious effort to know, understand and provide what all citizens need. In line with these, the Division Gender and Focal Point System will conduct its National Women's Month activities and Launching of 2022 GAD Activities.
- (2) This activity aims to: (a) motivate SDO Benguet personnel and learners to engage themselves in the activities empowering themselves; (b) establish a Gender and Development project flow for the year 2022; (c) empower women and girls to be the agents of change – to contribute in promoting gender equity and equality; (d) to recognize schools' programs in celebration of the women's month; and (e) develop researches on Gender and Development.
- (3) All personnel, teaching and non-teaching are encouraged to submit their researches on Gender and Development through the Division Research and Planning section for the research symposium which will be scheduled this month, depending on the availability of the research panel. Kindly prepare at least 6-7 slides during the presentation. See attached format of slides for presentation. Schools are requested to submit their 5-minute video on the celebration of the Women's Month and GAD activities to sgod.smn@gmail.com until March 15, 2022. Videos shall be likewise played at DepEd Tayo Benguet page. See attached contest criteria.
- (4) The opening of the Women's Month Celebration and launching of GAD activities will be held on March 7, 2022 at the SDO Adivay Hall with the onsite participation of PSDSs, Coordinating Principals and other SDO Benguet personnel and to be livestreamed via DepEd Tayo Benguet page. (1) <i>Theme</i>	The video presentation is anchored on the International and National Women's Month Celebration (#we make change work for women) and Division Gender and Development project LAVENDER (Lavishing Equity... Nurturing a Gender lens)	20%
(2) <i>Content</i>	School activities are focused on the following principles: (1) Leading, accelerating and venerating equality among men and women; (3) Continuous programs for LGBTQIA, PWDs and Elders amidst cultural diversity; (4) Defying abuse and violence through empowerment and (5) Rigorous educational campaign on equity among I-Benguet learners and communities. Functionality of the School GFPS (Gender and Development Focal Point System) is evident.	40%
(3) <i>Organization</i>	Video presentations are smooth and organized. Transition between scenes is logical and effective, background distractions are minimal.	10%
(4) <i>Quality</i>	Music and words are loud enough to hear; images are in focus, lighting is appropriate and camera work is steady.	10%
(5) <i>Creativity</i>	Interesting use of camera angle, sound effects/music, close up and distance shots	10%
(6) <i>Spelling, Usage and Mechanics</i>	Free of spelling and grammatical errors on any text that appears and scripted dialogue is free of grammatical errors.	10%
