


CONDUCT OF THE DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE 2023

- 1. Relative to the conduct of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) in July and the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) in April of 2023, this Office announces the conduct of the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) on April 14-16 at Benguet State University, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 2. As agreed during the virtual meeting of SPA Officers and Education Program Supervisors for Filipino and English, schools will conduct the School Press Conference to be followed by the District Press Conference. The first placers in the individual events and group events will represent their respective school in the District Press Conference and in the DSPC respectively. (Please see List of Contest Events in Enclosure 1.)
- 3. The Division shall implement the National and Regional Offices' "No School Paper, No Contestant" policy. Only learners from schools with school paper, English and/or Filipino, are allowed to compete in the various individual contest.
- 4. For the school paper contests, entries to be submitted will be hard copies, printed on long bond papers, and with colored front and back pages.
- 5. Registration fee in the amount of 300 pesos per participant will be collected for the professional fees of speakers and judges, conference materials, certificates, and other incidental expenses.
- 6. School paper advisers shall pay 60 pesos for their annual dues while campus journalists shall pay 30 pesos for membership fee.









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- 7. Working committee chairs and members are assigned to ensure the successful conduct of the DSPC. (See Enclosure No. 2 for the complete list.)
- 8. Proctors for the individual contests will be identified during the meeting of officers before the DSPC.
- 9. Participants during the DSPC shall be entitled for two-days service credits since the activity shall be conducted from Friday to Sunday. (See Enclosure No. 3 for the matrix of activities.)
- 10. Participants shall be billeted in nearby DepEd Schools to include La Trinidad Central School, Buyagan Elementary School, and Balili Elementary School. Food and transportation for the participants shall be charged from the schools' MOOE or local fund subject to usual accounting and auditing.
