



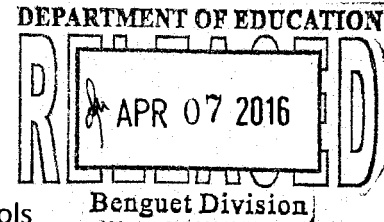

**2016 REGIONAL MASS TRAINING OF GRADE 5 TEACHERS**



**TO:** Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisors  
Elementary School Heads and Grade 5 Teachers of Public Elementary Schools

1. In line with the progressive implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the Department of Education through the Regional and Schools Division Office will conduct the Mass Training of Grade 5 teachers in different venues in La Trinidad and Baguio City on April 10-16, 2016.
2. In this mass training, all participants are expected to:
  - a. appreciate the K to 12 coded curriculum and use the curriculum guides, teaching guides and learning materials correctly and efficiently;
  - b. demonstrate understanding of the issues/ concerns relative to content, performance standards, assessment and rating system;
  - c. identify the most appropriate pedagogies, and understand how to localize localize/ indigenize the curriculum;
  - d. cite concrete measures or interventions to assist all types of students; and
  - e. cite connections of daily teaching and learning to the development of learning outcomes.
3. All EPSs and teachers who shall be teaching in Grade 5 for the SY 2016-2017 are required to attend and complete the 7-day training (See attached enclosure for the training venues and billeting areas).
4. Stay-in participants may check-in in the morning of Sunday, April 10 in their billeting places.
5. The plenary session starts on April 10, 1 pm to be held in 2 venues. Participants from Tublay, La Trinidad, Buguias, Sablan, Kapangan, Kibungan and Mankayan will have their plenary session at the NEAP-R Hall while participants from Atok, Itogon 2, Kabayan, Bakun, Bokod, Tuba and Itogon 1 shall proceed to the Adival Hall.
6. Participants may bring virus free USB and stay-in participants are requested to bring extra blankets, toiletries and other personal necessities good for seven days. Children of participants are not allowed in the conference halls nor sleep in the billeting quarters.
7. Board and/or lodging, training supplies/ needs/ materials, hire of conference halls, water and electricity expenses in schools used as sessions halls and travel expenses of participants and speakers from their billeting areas to the seminar venues shall be charged against DepED MTOT funds while travel and other incidental expenses of participants from their stations to the training venues during the mass training shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Members of the working committees and other information are found in the enclosure.
9. Six-day service credits and/ or COCs shall be given to teacher participants/ facilitators/ members of the secretariat whichever is applicable.
10. Immediate and widest dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is hereby enjoined.
