

## PARTICIPATION TO THE 2022 FIRST QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED) ACTIVITIES, AND OBSERVANCE OF FIRE PREVENTION MONTH

- 1. In relation to the approved National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Memorandum No. 21, s. 2022 re: Conduct of the CY 2022 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill, the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) enjoins schools and offices across all levels of the Department of Education (DepEd) to participate in the 2022 First Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED).

### REMINDERS WHEN CONDUCTING EQ DRILL ESPECIALLY DURING THE LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE

Due to limitations in the conduct of mass gatherings and adherence to health protocols, NSED exercises requiring physical interaction, particularly evacuation drills in DepEd offices and schools, are hereby suspended. However, all DepEd personnel and learners are enjoined to practice the "duck, cover and hold" procedure simultaneously at the set time.


Aside from the scheduled online activities presented in the Memorandum, here are other suggested school-based activities that can be included to further raise awareness regarding earthquake drill;

- 1. Intensify the information, education and communication (IEC) campaign by displaying information on earthquake preparedness measure at the offices and school bulletins or through online forum/fora such as social media platforms and video conferences.
- Let learners accomplish the Family Earthquake Preparedness Homework<sup>1</sup> and present the result to the PTA and barangay officials for consideration in the school and community preparedness planning, as mandated in DO 27, s. 2015.

### GUIDELINES ON THE SUBMISSION OF THE 2022 FIRST QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED) REPORTS

- 1. After the conduct of the actual EQ Drill, the School DRRM Coordinator is required to submit the Accomplishment Report using the most convenient means:
  - a) For schools/coordinators with access to internet, fill out the Google form link,
     https://bit.ly/LuzonSchools1Q within 3 days after the conduct of said activity.
  - b) For schools with no or limited access to internet connection, accomplish the OFFLINE NSED ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT (Annex B), scan the signed report and submit to the Division DRRM Coordinator using the fastest means of communications such as, FB Messenger (Nerissa Barbosa), email (DRRM.depedbenguet@gmail.com)
- For documentation purposes (aligned with SBM), the School DRRM coordinators must file their duly signed accomplishment report. No need to submit hardcopy of said report to the division office. The report submitted via electronic means and via online will suffice for the Division DRRM Coordinator's monitoring purposes.
