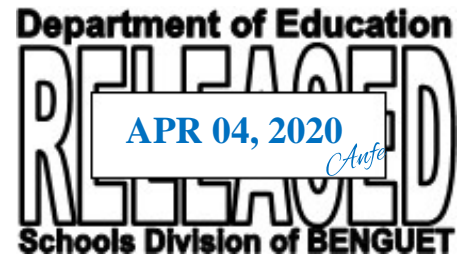

SUBJECT: FIRST QUARTER CID PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT THROUGH TELECONFERENCING

1. In line with the overall efforts of the Schools Division of Benguet to ensure the continued delivery of basic education services in spite of the present COVID-19 pandemic, the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will be having its **First Quarter Professional Development through Teleconferencing** on April 7, 2020, which will start at 8:30 o'clock in the morning.
2. The teleconference aims to:
 - a. Report accomplishments and outputs in implementing the two main strategies reported by CID in the PSCP: **Work from Home and from Classroom to Classhome** strategies;
 - b. Strengthen the reporting system as bases in forwarding recommendation/s for policy/issuance/action; and
 - c. Share issues and concerns on the implementation of curriculum-related measures during the ECQ period based on the enhanced process manuals of each unit/section.
3. With the OIC-Schools Division Superintendent and the OIC-Assistant Schools Division Superintendent as consultants, the participants to this activity are CID personnel comprising the following: CID Chief, eight (8) Education Program Supervisors, 14 Public Schools District Supervisors/District Heads, two (2) Education Program Specialists for ALS, One (1) Project Development Officer II-LR, one (1) Librarian, and two (2) Administrative Assistant/Aide.
4. Each CID personnel is given 10 minutes to report his/her accomplishment from the Work from Home arrangement. As such, each participant is required to have a working laptop/desktop/cell phone with earphone/head set and stable internet connection during the activity.
5. Internet load of P300 shall be provided to each participant to be charged to Division Fund subject to auditing rules and regulations.
6. The flow of the teleconference and the suggested guide for reporting accomplishment report are found in the enclosures. Other details will be posted in the *BenguetCID20* facebook account and group chats.
7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned personnel is enjoined.
