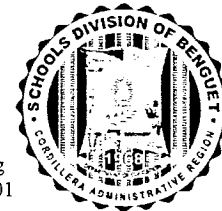

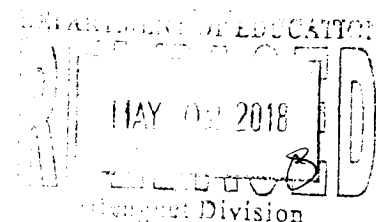

SUBJECT: 2018 BRIGADA ESKWELA KICK OFF



1. With the *theme "Pagkakaisa Para sa Handa, Ligtas at Matatag na Paaralan Tungo sa Magandang Kinabukasan"*, the Schools Division of Benguet shall hold the 2018 Brigada Eskwela kick off program at Ampusungan National High School, Bakun, Benguet on May 25, 2018.¹

2. The kick off program shall commence with a motorcade with starting point at Acop, Caponga, Tublay going to Ampusungan NHS, Bakun, Benguet, following the Acop-Sinipsip-Bakun Road.

Attached herein as Enclosure No.1 is the List of participants from the Schools Division Office along with some reminders in connection thereto.

3. All other schools in the division shall simultaneously conduct their respective launch starting May 28, 2018. The monitoring of schools relative to the conduct of Brigada Eskwela shall likewise be simultaneous from May 28, 2018 to June 2, 2018.

4. A district consolidated report on the conduct of the Brigada Eskwela shall be submitted to the Division Office on or before June 15, 2018.

5. All SDO Benguet Employees are encouraged to join the Brigada Eskwela activities by offering their skills, sharing their time or providing assistance in kind and support to public schools near their residence. Interested employees are given two days to do volunteer work on official time.

6. Meals and snacks during the kick off program shall be borne by the host school while transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
