

ADDENDUM/CORIGENDUM TO DIVISION MEMO NO. 16 S. 2023 2023 Benguet Provincial Sports Meet

To provide an update on the conduct of the 2023 Benguet Provincial Athletic Meet, the following addendum/corrigendum is hereby issued:

- 1. Arrival of delegations is April 1, 2023; solidarity meeting is at 10:00AM at the BSU Gym. There will be pre-games in the afternoon in all the events on this date.
- 2. April 3, 2023 will be the parade to start at 7:00AM. Assembly area is at BSU Centennial Park to BSU ground. Opening program follows. Delegations shall bring along with them their flags. Schools in La Trinidad who have marching band/drum and lyres are requested to join the parade in a voluntary basis.
- 3. Archery secondary boys and girls, tennis elementary boys and girls, and 5 X 5 basketball elementary boys, and secondary boys and girls are additional events to be played.
- 4. Composition of dance sports per delegation is one pair Latin and one pair Standard for elementary and likewise with the secondary.
- 5. All games shall follow the Palarong Pambansa guidelines (DepEd Memo No. 05 s. 2023). However, team games that will not be played in the CARAA Meet can use the district-wide selection/fielding of athletes. However, in futsal, it must follow the school sports club composition.
- 6. In measured games (running, throwing, archery), winners must meet the Palarong Pambansa standard qualifying time/measurement to qualify to the CARAA Meet. All TMs of the events will submit qualifiers to the management.
- 7. Athletes who develop symptoms (cough, colds, fever, sore throat) five days prior to the meet until the last day of the BPAM regardless of vaccination status shall undergo antigen testing at their respective Municipal Health Office/ Provincial Capitol. Confirmed cases of COVID-19 shall be immediately isolated and quarantined. Hence, billeting schools shall make available isolation rooms.
- 8. There is no suspension of classes on the duration of the meet. However, in billeting schools, they shall adopt appropriate approach of conducting classes. Athletes who missed their classes will be given make-up activities/lessons.
- 9. Awarding of medals and certificates to winning athletes and coaches will be done in the playing areas. Hence, there must be a secretariat in each event to take charge of the paperwork.
- 10. Except for IP and Para games, all events are regular. Winning athletes are entitled for medals from first to third place (Gold, Silver & Bronze Medals) and are counted for in the tally. Team game medals are counted as one, but all the team members will be given. Individual event medals are counted individually.
- 11. Delegation management are advised to allocate funds for water and electricity consumption in their billeting schools.
