

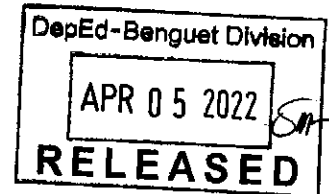

Radio Based Instruction (RBI) Orientation and Simulation

1. The Department of Education has included in its Blended Learning Framework the use of radio as a modality to reach learners who have limited or no access to the more popular online -based lessons. As a form of distance learning, it will expand access to education to students living within the community. Traditionally, radio is used in information dissemination, and families maintain battery -operated AM/FM transistor radios and other modes of radio broadcast in areas without electricity.
2. Radio-Based Instruction (RBI) program is one of the alternative learning delivery modalities using radio broadcast to deliver the lesson using the student self-learning modules (SLM). It aims to provide learning opportunities to listeners as complimentary learning while using their SLMs in the absence of actual face to face interaction. Learners from rural areas reached by radio frequencies will benefit for this type of learning.
3. Currently, Batuan Elementary School of the District of Tuba is the sole school who has established a functional School Radio Based station in the Division of Benguet. They were able to craft different subjects/ topics from different grade levels wherein all the scripts and audio recordings are aligned with the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) of the different learning areas addressing learning needs of the learners in their school.
4. It is the goal of the Division of Benguet to expand the use of Radio as a modality not only in the elementary but also in the secondary level. It is in this connection that an orientation shall be conducted on April 19, 2022 , 8:30 am at Batuan Elementary School, Tuba, Benguet.
