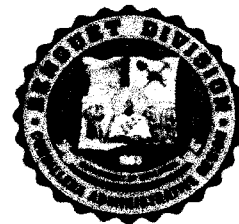

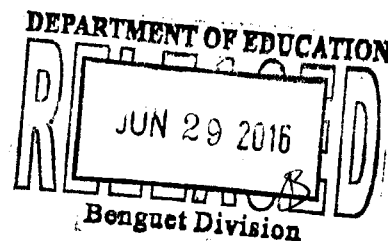

**Subject:** **DENGUE SURVEILLANCE AND DENGUE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION IN SCHOOLS**

**Date:** June 28, 2016



1. The numbers of Dengue cases are on the rise in the different municipalities of Benguet as reported by DOH - CAR. On review, there was a 298% increase of dengue cases in 2015 compared to 2014. Thirteen (13) deaths were reported in CAR alone. One of the mortalities was an adult from Tuba, Benguet. Clustering of cases last year was seen in Bokod, Kapangan and La Trinidad.
2. As the rainy season approaches, there are increasing reports of Dengue cases in the schools which prompted the need to intensify the Dengue surveillance and anti-Dengue activities in schools.
3. Activities for Dengue Surveillance include the following:
  - a. Reporting of Dengue cases from the schools to the Schools Division Office:
    - ✓ School head or school clinic teacher to SMS/text report dengue cases in schools
    - ✓ School Health Personnel to submit monthly consolidated report on Dengue cases following attached format.
  - b. Intensify the DOST led National Dengue Vector Surveillance (NDVS) where sentinel schools are assigned to implement the Ovicidal/Larvicidal (OL) Trap and weekly reports are uploaded into the web to track mosquito population density and the risk of Dengue transmission in that area.
    - ✓ List of sentinel schools and monthly report format for this activity is attached to this memorandum.
4. Anti-Dengue activities to be conducted in schools and DepEd offices shall include but is not limited to the following activities:
  - Suspension of wearing skirts and short pants in schools with cases of Dengue among the school population or in the community. Appropriate clothing shall include long sleeves, long pants and closed shoes.
  - Institutionalize weekly and simultaneous clean-up drive activities within the school compound and in the community if possible.
  - Encourage practice of prompt consultation when having fever for 2 days
  - Inform and educate school children, teachers, parents and other community members about the nature of the dengue disease and its prevention.
5. Wide and immediate dissemination and compliance to this memorandum is desired.

- ✓ cc: District or School nurse

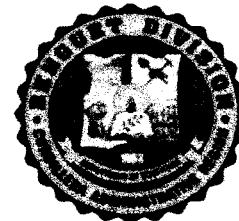
**B. The School Health personnel shall consolidate dengue cases from schools under her/his charge and submit a report every last Friday of the month.**
