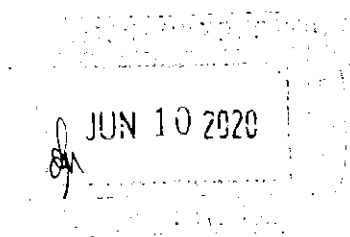

District-based Implementation of the Open Education Resource (OER) as one platform in digitizing Quality Assured Learning Modules/Materials

1. With the conclusion of the Training of Trainers of the OER from June 2 to 5, 2020, the ICT unit in collaboration with the CID-LRM section will be monitoring the implementation of the District Based-OER training, to be conducted on various schedules per District.
2. The District ICT Coordinator shall accomplish the training design in accordance to their municipal COVID-19 Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) rules and regulations will not be violated. The training design shall also identify the OER topics along as who impart will impart to the target participants.
3. Moreover, the District ICT Coordinator can send invitations to other OER speakers from other Districts to take part in their District OER implementation. The final District OER training design shall be posted in the OER Workplace page RCA-BGT-OER team to be a reference in monitoring their conduct of District OER implementation.
4. The training can be conducted via teleconference mode using any available platform provided by DepEd either Google meet or Microsoft Teams. The training can be conducted via a pure plenary style or a breakaway-session or a mixture of both plenary mixed with beak-away session. A face to face conduct of this training is strongly discourage, unless it is properly coordinated with their municipal COVID-19 IATF.
5. The participants are required to have their own laptops/Desktops in top condition with the latest OS and updates, smartphones, stable internet/data access and with access to their personal DepEd emails. Also, participants are required to have with them their crafted formative/summative modules as a source when they will craft their own OER learning materials.
6. The ICT unit will be providing a ₱ 300.00 worth of Internet/data load to ten (10) participants to be utilized by the Division/District OER teacher(s) or given to selected participant(s) charged against the DCP support fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. While identified participants can charge their internet/data load against their School MOOE following the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned personnel is enjoined.
