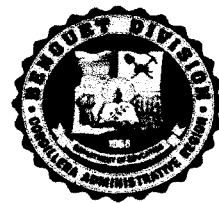

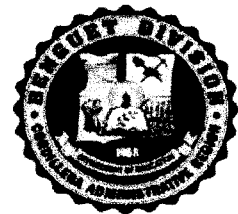

The round metal gong of the Cordillera known locally as "gangsá" is a symbol of the upland people's culture that has been passed on from generation to another.
The profile of a person blowing a "tangguyob" represents a community being called for an important matter or action.
The lines that shape the mountains, the rice terraces, clouds and rivers symbolize the connectivity and flow of human interaction in a geographic area such as the Cordillera.
All the symbols combined represent unity and harmony of its people with culture and environment in beating the gong for self-determination.



PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES

- o Participants coming from Kabayan and Bokod will follow the route starting from Pacdal Circle – Teachers' Camp-Session Road – Magsaysay Street – La Trinidad – Buyagan – Benguet Multipurpose Gym, Wangal;
- o Participants coming from Sablan will follow the route starting from Sablan – Longlong – Benguet Multi Purpose Gym, Wangal;
- o Participants coming from Halsema Highway (Kapangan, Bakun, Kibungan, Mankayan, Buguias, Atok, Tublay) will follow the route starting from Tublay – Municipal Ground – Betag – Puguís – Benguet Multi Purpose Gym, Wangal;
- o Participants coming from Itogon will follow the route starting from Panagbenga Park – Session road – Magsaysay street – La Trinidad – Puguís – Benguet Multipurpose Gym, Wangal;
- o Participants coming from La Trinidad will follow the route starting from Km 3 City Limit – Betag – Buyagan – Benguet Multipurpose Gym, Wangal, or they may choose to join the group coming from Tublay;
- o Those not joining the motorcade or without vehicles to proceed directly to the Benguet Multipurpose Gym, Wangal.
