

CALL FOR VOLUNTARY DONATIONS FOR OUR DISPLACED DEPED LEARNERS AND PERSONNEL IN THE MARAWI SIEGE

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 98, s. 2017, *Emergency Measures in Response to the Marawi Situation*, The External Partnerships Service (EPS) is continuously engaging the private sector in raising support for displaced learners and teachers due to the insurgency in Marawi.
2. According to Autonomous Region for Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) Education Secretary John Magno, an estimate of 22,222 learners, 2,205 teachers and 87 public schools were affected by the ongoing conflict in the area.
3. While assistance from private sectors have been providing support, the public sector and DepEd field offices are also encouraged to mobilize support to provide the immediate needs of learners and teachers such as Teachers' Kits, Learners' Kits, Cleaning Kits, Instructional Materials, Chairs and Tents.
4. The resources assigned for DepEd-Cordillera Administrative Region are **first aid kits and slippers**.
5. **All District Supervisors/Coordinating Principals, School Heads are hereby requested to facilitate mobilization of assistance in their respective jurisdictions.** Donations in-kind must be the assigned items for DepEd-CAR (first aid kits and slippers). Due to high cost of freight, it is suggested that financial assistance is encouraged.
6. Please submit the donations to the Division Officer, through the Social Mobilization and Networking Section not later than July 14, 2017 for proper recording and accounting of all donations, and be sent to Iligan City National High School, Iligan City the soonest possible time.
7. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
