

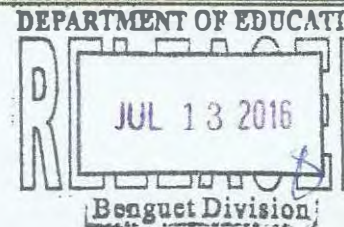

NATIONAL DISASTER CONSCIOUSNESS MONTH (NDCM) CELEBRATION

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/Coordinating Principals
District DRRM Coordinators, Elem. and Sec.
All Elementary and Secondary School Heads
School DRRM Coordinators
Public and Private Schools

1. Pursuant to Executive Order No. 137, s. 1999 declaring the Month of July of Every Year as National Disaster Consciousness Month and Institutionalizing the Civil Defense Deputation Program, the DepEd – Disaster Risk Reduction Management Services (DRRMS) suggested relevant activities in observance of the 2016 National Disaster Consciousness Month (NDCM) this whole month of July.
2. All schools are expected to undertake the following activities:
 - Display of streamers indicating this year's theme (see enclose);
 - Orientation on the different health hazards;
 - Devoting classroom time for discussion of preparedness, mitigation and prevention during the rainy season;
 - Symposium or forum on DRRM;
 - **Conduct of jingle-making and mascot design contests;** and
 - Other related activities to ensure heightened awareness and consciousness among school administrators, teachers, personnel and school children nationwide on what to do before, during and after the occurrence of all forms of possible hazards in your respective areas.
3. Enclosed is the mechanics for the Jingle-making and Mascot Design Contests. Winning entries at the **school level** will be submitted to the Division Office on or before **August 5, 2016**.
4. All activities conducted in observance with the National Disaster Consciousness Month should be well-documented and submitted to the Division Office through the Division DRRM Coordinator on or before August 5, 2016.
5. Immediate dissemination, and compliance of all is expected.

MECHANICS FOR THE JINGLE-MAKING AND MASCOT DESIGN CONTESTS

- *The Jingle and Mascot Design Contests shall revolve around this year's NDCM theme, "Kahandaan at Pagtugon sa Sakuna, Tungkulin ng Bawat Isa".*
- *Division level entries must be submitted on or before **August 5, 2016 (Tuesday)** at the SGOD – DRRM Office, 3rd Flr., Division Office of Benguet. Entries must be properly labeled with the following data:*

Name of School, School I.D., Name of Learners, Name of Coach

Jingle-making Contest

1. The contest is open to all public and private schools of Benguet. Each district may submit more than one (1) entry.
2. Each group shall consist of three to **five (3 – 5) pupils/students**.
3. Jingles can either be in English or Filipino.
4. Entries will be in the form of an audio presentation, saved in a CD with **.mp3 format file**.
5. The entry must be an **original composition** (tune and lyrics) **with musical accompaniment**.
6. Criteria for judging:
 - A. Originality – 30 pts.
 - B. Content – 30 pts.
 - C. Song mechanics (melody, musical accompaniment, etc.) – 20 pts.
 - D. Significance to the Theme – 20 pts.
7. The best entry will be submitted to the Regional Office, which in turn, shall choose the best regional entry to the national level competition.

Mascot Design Contest

1. The contest is open to all elementary and secondary schools of Benguet. Each district may submit multiple entries but each design will be judged individually.
2. All entries must adhere to the following rules:
 - Submissions must have a 250-word description which includes an explanation for the inspiration of the design.
 - It should be saved in a white background and should fit in a letter-sized paper (8.5" x 11").
 - Files should be high-resolution in 300 dpi.jpeg format.
3. Criteria for judging:
 - Originality – 30 pts.
 - Design – 30 pts.
 - Child-friendliness – 20 pts.
 - Significance to DRRM – 20 pts.
4. The best entry will be submitted to the Regional Office, which in turn, shall choose the best regional entry to the national level competition.
