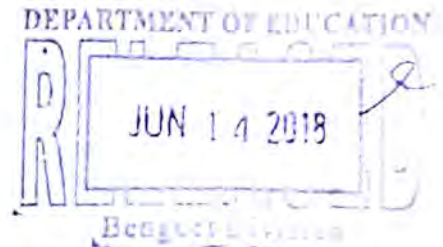



TRAINER'S METHODOLOGY CERTIFICATE 1 (TMC1) COURSE FOR TLE/TVL AND ALS TEACHERS

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum 320, s. 2017 re- Package for Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL) teachers of strengthened Technical Vocational Program (STVEP) and Teachers of Alternative Learning System (ALS), there will be a Trainers Methodology Certificate 1 (TMC1) Course which will be held at Baguio School of Arts and Trade, 80 Military Cut-Off, Baguio City.
2. There will be 51 TLE/TVL and ALS teachers identified to undergo this training which will be conducted on June 19, 2018 to July 20, 2018. See attached list of participants.
3. This TMC1 course is a joint activity between SDO Benguet and the Baguio School of Arts and Trade.
4. The training objectives are as follows:
 - a. upgrade the qualification of junior and senior high teachers under TVL strands.
 - b. come up with qualified and competent TVET trainers.
 - c. enhance and improve teachers' competence on the new trends, methods and techniques in teaching for them to apply in the classroom setting.
5. Participants are advised to bring laptop and other ~~needed~~ instructional materials needed for the duration of the course. See attached list of participants.
6. An amount of Php9,400.00 shall be allotted per participant for registration and assessment fee, while transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
