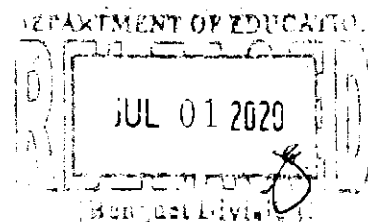

SUBJECT: **TRAINING-WORKSHOP OF SELECTED MAPEH TEACHERS ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODULES/ADM IN MAPEH QUARTER 2, GRADES 1-12, Batch 2, ONLINE/OFFLINE on July 8-30, 2020**

1. Pursuant to DepEd's Sulong Edukalidad and its battle cry on the continuous delivery of quality basic education and in support to Regional Memorandum No. 090 s. 2020 re: Development of Learning Resources and Survey on Alternative Learning Delivery Modes, the Schools Division of Benguet plan for contingency measures relative to the implementation of Basic Education-Learning Continuity (BE-LC) Plan should the quarantine period be extended until the first quarter of the next school year.
2. In connection, SDO Curriculum Implementation Divisions, through the Learning Resource Management Sections will be facilitating the development of learning resources by the MAPEH teachers prioritizing First and Second Quarters to be done in 2 batches. The learning resources shall be K to 12 MELC-Based modular type, which may be delivered through modular distance learning on an offline mode.

 - b. equipped with the knowledge and skills in developing a user friendly modular type learning resources as Alternative Delivery Modes that are appropriate for online/offline teaching-learning.
 - c. developed a MELC-based module outputs in the assigned MAPEH Component/SPA Discipline ready for quality assurance.

Pursuant to DepEd's Sulong Edukalidad and its battle cry on the continuous delivery of quality basic education and in support to Regional Memorandum No. 090 s. 2020 re: Development of Learning Resources and Survey on Alternative Learning Delivery Modes, Schools Division of Benguet plan for contingency measures relative to curriculum implementation and learning delivery should the quarantine period be extended until the first quarter of the next school year.

After each online session shall be a hands-on workshop in the continuous development, improvement/revisions, enhancement/finalization/packaging and submission respectively. Online/Offline platforms/media such as Messenger Chats, Mobile phone calls and text messaging will be utilized in all communications and transactions among the participants, partners, coaches and monitors for technical assistance along the processes of the module development. Email adds and sourcing out/downloading and uploading needed materials like (digital/audio-videos, prints, pictures/illustrations, etc.) are also necessary in the module development.

8. Module developers/participants to the training-workshop are the identified MAPEH and SPA teachers from the different schools of SDO-Benguet, elementary and secondary. Please see attached lists.
9. Participants are reminded/conditioned for a whole day webinar/online in all the scheduled first 3 sessions. Thus, each participant shall locate a spot with stable internet access to ensure full participation and gain information from the inputs/discussions online.
10. Internet /WIFI load will be provided each participant to use during the first 3 sessions online and during offline chats, calls, and text messaging while on hands-on write shops. The cell card loads shall be chargeable against 2020 SDO MOOE/HRTD fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
