
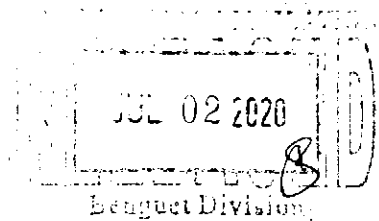

SUBJECT: DIVISION PILOT TESTING OF BLENDED/DISTANCE LEARNING DELIVERY

DATE: June 30, 2020

1. In line with the Schools Division of Benguet Learning Continuity Operational Plan (LCOP) and as part of the preparation for the opening of the School Year 2020-2021 sans face to face learning, a **Division Pilot Testing of Blended/Distance Learning Delivery** in the different learning areas shall be conducted on July 13-24, 2020 in selected schools.
2. As a complementary activity to the region-wide pilot testing, the division activity aims to:
 - a. gauge the readiness of schools in implementing the various modalities of blended/distance learning delivery;
 - b. determine the applicability and viability of available learning resources based on the needs and situation of teachers and learners;
 - c. gather significant feedbacks, issues and concerns as bases for the provision of continuing technical assistance by the schools' division and regional offices; and
 - d. provide guidance to schools and learning centers in relation to learning delivery in this new normal period.

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4. As per Regional Memorandum No. 164, s. 2020, blended/distance learning modality shall be characterized by the delivery of lessons to all learners in the comfort and safety of their homes through the following methods:
 - a. Printed or digital modules delivered to the homes of learners, or picked up by their parents or guardians or volunteers at designated places, with coordinated schedules;
 - b. Online learning through the use of online platforms like DepEd Commons, Learning Resource Management System (LRMDS), and other DepEd-authorized learning management systems and platforms (example: authorized/approved virtual class, messenger)
 - c. Television or radio-based instruction; and
 - d. Blend of printed modules and online or blend of printed modules and TV/radio-based instructions or blend of printed modules, online, and TV/radio-based instruction.
5. The target activities relative to this undertaking are found in Enclosure 1.
6. The identified/selected schools are enjoined to make the necessary preparations such as the following: learning resources to be piloted, advocacies to concerned parents and stakeholders, selection of a maximum of 10 learners to participate in the piloting, process flow of learning blended/distance learning delivery, among others.
7. Teachers, school heads and other DepEd personnel who will be directly involved in this undertaking are entitled for a corresponding internet load subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is enjoined.
