“Responsible Pet Ownership Day”

Awarding of Most Responsive Municipal LGU’s to the Provincial Rabies Eradication and Control Program and On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest for Elementary, High School and Alternative Learning System (ALS) Students

Activity Rationale:

Rabies is a dreaded disease that still remains a threat to the Province of Benguet. For this year, we are proposing a “responsible pet ownership day” during the Adivay Festival because we believe that being a rabies-free province is worth celebrating. Through this activity, the efforts of the Municipal Local Governments (MLGUs) to keep the people of Benguet safe from this disease can be given due recognition. **Also, the festival is a good venue to showcase our youth’s artistic talents, while at the same time test their awareness of rabies and responsible pet ownership.**

Activity Description:

We would like to give tribute to the MLGUs particularly the Municipal Agriculture Offices (MAOs) for their conduct of rabies eradication activities such as mass vaccination, pet registration, pet population survey and information dissemination campaigns. A plaque of appreciation and cash prize will be awarded to the “most responsive LGUs” based on a set of criteria.

Similarly, an on-the-spot poster making contest for elementary, high school and ALS students shall be conducted. The theme of the contest shall be “responsible pet ownership for a rabies-free Benguet”. This is still part of our goal of educating the public especially the youth about rabies. This is our target age bracket because the 15 and under youth are the most susceptible to dog bites and rabies.

On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest

Contest Mechanics:

1. Venue: Benguet Sports Center multipurpose gymnasium, Wangal, La Trinidad
2. Time: start of program 8:00 a.m.; cut-off time for submission: 2:00 p.m.; awarding of prizes: 4:00 p.m.
3. Awarding shall start after the awarding of most responsive LGUs to give time for judging of artworks

The theme shall be “responsible pet ownership for a rabies-free Benguet” for all the three categories. Every school shall have only ONE representative PER category and he/she must be accompanied by ONE teacher as his/her coach. The categories are:

1. Elementary
2. High School
3. Alternative Learning System
