THREE-DAY CAMPUS JOURNALISM TRAINING FOR PROSPECTIVE SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS

- 1. In line with the DepEd's thrust of strengthening campus journalism as per Republic Act 7079 otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Schools Division of Benguet will be conducting a three-day Campus Journalism Training for Prospective Elementary School Paper Advisers in English and Filipino on May 22-24, 2019 at the Cordillera Regional Science High School, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
- 2. Participants to this training are prospective school paper advisers from selected elementary schools of the different districts as per attached list. Concerned school heads shall identify the teacher/s who will be attending this activity.
- 3. At the end of the training, the participants shall have:
 - a. gained knowledge and skills in writing news, features, editorial, column and sports articles as well as in photojournalism and lay out of school publication;
 - b. prepared sample articles and headlines in news, features and sports including photo and school paper layout; and
 - c. developed skills in coaching and mentoring students for involvement in campus journalism.
- 4. Each participant is expected to bring lap top, flash drive/external drive, extension wires, camera, notebook and pen during the activity.
- 5. Lunch and snacks of participants for three days shall be charged from the SDO Human Resource Training Development (HRTD) fund while transportation, lodging and other incidental expenses shall be charged from their respective school MOOE/local fund subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Teacher-participants, including the identified teacher-facilitators, are entitled for a three-day service credits in accordance with existing guidelines.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
