

COLLECTION OF NARRATIVE FEATURE STORIES, HISTORICAL PHOTOS, AND DOCUMENTATION OF PRESENT INITIATIVES OF SCHOOLS TOWARDS LEARNING RECOVERY

- 1. The Schools Division of Benguet will be commemorating its 55th Founding Anniversary on June 15, 2023 bearing the theme: "Pagpapahalaga sa Nakagisnan at Pagpapayabong sa Pamanang Yaman Tungo sa Matatag at Makabatang Ka-Benguetan." It may be recalled that SDO Benguet traces its humble beginning on June 15, 1968 from the enactment of Republic Act 5368, "An Act Reorganizing the School Division of the Province of Benguet-Baguio into Two School Divisions."
- 2. As part of the commemorative activities leading to its culminating program, the schools division will be collecting narrative feature stories about early schools, old photos with historical significance on education, and documentation of recent relevant initiatives towards learning recovery.
- 3. The narrative feature stories could contain any of the following subjects:
 - a. History of the earliest schools in the town or community;
 - b. Significant accounts about early teachers and administrators;
 - c. Anecdotes or encounters with previous Schools Division Superintendent/s;
 - d. Accounts about the early teaching-learning approaches;
 - e. Memories about the educational leaders in Benguet; and
 - f. Other stories related to educational development in Benguet.
- 4. Meanwhile, scanned and captioned old photos with historical significance in education will be collected in order to preserve these as part of our educational









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memorabilia as a division. Holders and owners of old photos, which may be in the 1960s to 2010 or before the advent of social media, shall be acknowledged.

- 5. In addition, schools and learning centers are encouraged to come up with creative documentation of their recent innovative initiatives in addressing learning gaps for possible inclusion in the exhibit during the celebration.
- 6. Creative documentation of such initiative in the form of videos or slide shows could also be submitted, which could be featured in our SDO Official Facebook page or in other online platforms.
- 7. These narrative feature stories, scanned and captioned old photos, and creative documentations of present initiatives toward learning recovery shall be submitted through email on or before June 5, 2023.
