

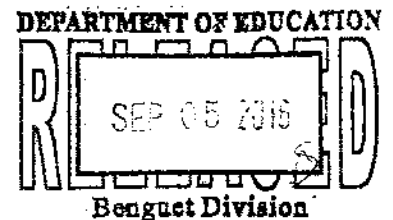

**SUBJECT: BENGUET TEACHERS' DAY SPORTS COMPETITION**

1. In connection with the celebration of the Benguet Teachers' Day on September 30, 2016 as covered by Provincial Ordinance Number 15 – 170 series 2015, there will be a sports competition for teachers in volleyball women, basketball men and table tennis men and women for both private and public elementary and secondary schools on September 17, 18, 24 and 25, 2016. Playing venues will be announced soon (See attached enclosure 1-4 for the guidelines and schedule of games).
2. Participants to this competition are teachers from both private and public, elementary and secondary schools. Regular, LGU and PTA Paid teachers are eligible to play except substitute teachers. Likewise, non-teaching personnel are not included.
3. Expenses incurred in connection with the sports participation shall be borne by their respective delegations.
4. Lunch and snacks of technical officials only shall be provided by the provincial general fund supplemental budget/fund raising on September 24 & 25, 2016.
5. Service credits and COCs shall be granted to the participants and technical officials.

## Enclosure 1

### Guidelines:

1. There shall be one (1) team each per district; elementary and secondary combined as one. Further listed as follows:
  - A) Public Elementary and secondary school teachers shall form one team each for volleyball women and basketball men per district.
  - B) Private elementary and secondary schools combined as one will form one (1) team each for volleyball women and basketball men.
  - C) Higher Education Institutions from elementary and secondary schools combined as one will form one (1) team.
  - D) Schools Division Office of Benguet personnel shall form one team each for volleyball women and basketball men.
  - E) There shall be two (2) entries per district for table tennis men and women for bracket A and B. Likewise, private schools and Higher Educational Institutions shall field two (2) players each for men and women.
2. Each team shall have twelve (12) maximum number of players for volleyball and basketball.
3. Single elimination shall apply in all games. Regulation game/ semi-running time is applied in basketball upon decision of the tournament managers in consultation with the coaches.
4. Ground rules shall be determined by the tournament managers and referees before the first game starts.
5. Public school teachers including SDO personnel will conduct elimination (basketball, volleyball & table tennis) games on September 17 and 18, 2016. Emerging winners will face the private schools and HEIs on September 24 and 25, 2016. Playing venues will be announced later.
6. Team captains shall act as playing coach for their teams or may have their option to hire one.
7. Technical Officials will be taken from public and private schools and HEIs on a voluntary basis.
8. All teams must bring with them their respective nets and balls for use in the games.
9. Each team may decide to have their uniform.
