
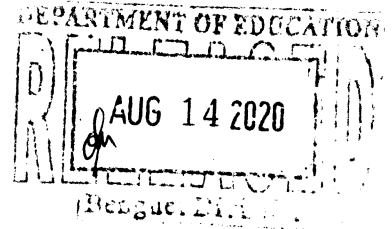

SUBJECT: **WEBINAR ON SCRIPT WRITING AND BROADCASTING OF RADIO-BASED LESSONS**

DATE: August 14, 2020

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1. In line with its commitment to provide more flexible learning options for all types of learners in basic education, the Schools Division of Benguet recently partnered with two local radio stations for the free airing of radio-based instructions during the School Year 2020-2021.
2. As a crucial step to capacitate potential teacher-radio broadcasters to be involved in facilitating radio-based lessons, there will be a **Division Webinar on Script Writing and Broadcasting of Radio-Based Instructions** on August 18, 2020 from 9:00 o'clock in the morning onwards for selected pool of radio broadcasters in the different learning areas.
3. The participants for this webinar are 12 teachers from each of the eight (8) learning areas (Aral Pan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, English, Filipino, MAPEH, Math, Science, TLE/EPP), six (6) participants from the Alternative Learning System, two (2) from Mother Tongue and one (1) from Kindergarten to be identified by each learning area Education Program Supervisor. The final list shall be submitted to the Curriculum Implementation (CID) on or before Monday, August 17, 2020 so that the link for the webinar through google meet could be shared to each identified participant before the activity proper.
4. At the end of the webinar, the teacher-participants shall have:
 - a. gained basic knowledge and skills in script writing and broadcasting of radio-based instruction,
 - b. prepared scripts for radio-based instructions covering crucial lessons found in the specific modules of the different learning areas during the first week of the opening of classes, and
 - c. recorded clear and acceptable radio-based instructions for airing over the radio stations.
5. An internet load of P500 each participant shall be provided from the Schools Division Fund subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.
