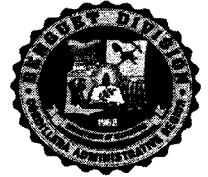

Subject: **2015 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS: "SINING TANGHALAN"**
(MAPEH)

1. Relative to the annual conduct of FESTIVAL OF TALENTS in all learning areas, the **2015 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS for MAPEH: "SINING TANGHALAN"** will be conducted on December 3-4, 2015 to be held at the Benguet NHS and DepED –RNEAP.
2. The Festival aims to:
 - a. provide opportunities for students to showcase their talents and learning in MAPEH through an exhibition of their products and performances;
 - b. extend parallel learning sessions for teachers and students to enhance their knowledge and skills in their respective field of interest; and
 - c. provide an avenue to gather feedbacks to further improve implementation of the MAPEH Curriculum.
3. The contest matrix, guidelines, criteria and mechanics on the different exhibitions are presented in the enclosures 1, 2 and 3 for reference.
4. Participants to the festival are the 1st place winner/s in the District level Festival of Talents.
5. No registration shall be collected from the participants. Their food and travelling expenses of the student-participants and coaches maybe charged against available school/local funds. Lunch and snacks of the Contest Administrators and Facilitators, tokens for the Judges, and Trophies/Certificates shall be provided chargeable against the SEF-PLGU and Division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

1. Participation

2. ELIGIBILITY AND MECHANICS

A. Eligibility

The 2015 "Sining Tanghalan" shall be participated by bonafide pupils/students during the school year 2015-2016 duly certified by the school head.

Only the winners in the 2015 District Level Festival of Talents are qualified to participate in the 2015 Division "Sining Tanghalan" who meets the guidelines set in the contest areas where he/she is participating.

B. The District Coordinators must submit the following;

- Official Entry Form of the Sining Tanghalan 2015(See attached) shall be accomplished by district attached with:
 - a. Certificate from the School Head that the Teachers are bonafide staff of the school being represented and are designated advisers/coaches of the student-participants.
 - b. Certification from the School Head that states the student participants' grade level and school being represented.

C. Deadline for the Submission of District Entries:

District entries shall be submitted or emailed to mapeh.sdobenguet@yahoo.com using the attached **prescribed entry form** which shall be submitted on or before November 27, 2015 at 5:00PM attached with other supporting requirements(Chants. Late submission will mean disqualification from joining the "Sining Tanghalan" events. Substitution of names for the events is subject to the approval of the Schools Division Superintendent and Sining Tanghalan Focal Person/s.

D. Mechanics in the conduct of the skills exhibition

The mechanics & guidelines set per contest area and the contest MATRIX shall strictly be followed. Any violations made by the contestants/coaches shall automatically result to disqualification.

E. Awarding and determining Championship-results

There shall be 3 place winners (1st to 3rd place) in in each contest area to be awarded Certificates of recognition for both the contestants and coaches. Trophies will be awarded to the school of the 1st placers winner per contest area, the champion districts per category/level (Elementary and Secondary) and the Over-all Champion.

The championship per Category(Elem. & Sec.) and the Over-all championship shall be determined by the total points earned by the districts.

The Championship per category/level and the Over-all Championship Results shall be determined by Points System. Points are assigned as follows:

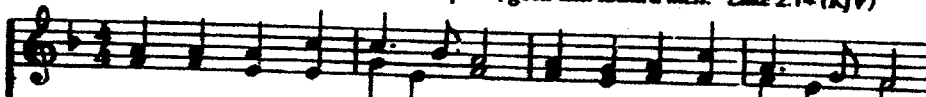
