

**SUBJECT: 2018 BENGUET TEACHERS' DAY SPORTS AND IP GAMES  
COMPETITION**

1. Prior to the Benguet Teachers' Day celebration on September 27 and 28, 2018, there will be a sports competition for teachers in basketball men, volleyball men & women, table tennis men & women, billiards men & women, table tennis men & women, darts men & women and chess men & women.
2. Participants to this competition are the teachers and teaching related personnel from private and public, elementary, secondary and Higher Educational Institution schools. Regular, LGU, PTA Paid and substitute teachers are eligible to play. Non-teaching personnel are not included.
3. There are eighteen (18) teams to play in this sports activities. (See enclosure 3)
4. Each player shall contribute fifty pesos (P50.00) to be collected per district for the hire of referees to officiate in the quarter finals up to the finals. Last submission is August 4, 2018.
5. Required number of players per team shall follow the DepEd standard. (See enclosure 2)
6. Teams must prepare a duly accomplished gallery of players duly signed by their respective officials to be submitted on or before August 4, 2018. (See enclosure 1)
7. Elimination rounds shall be played in their respective zones, grouped as: North Division, South Division, Central Division and Private Division. (See enclosure 3)
8. The top two (2) winners from each group shall play for the quarter finals. It is a winner takes all. All teams are asked to provide their own equipment/implements.
9. The IP games will be played on September 27, 2018 at the Benguet Sports Multi-Purpose gym. The number of players per team are included in enclosure 2.
10. All players are required to attend the opening program on August 4, 2018 at 8:30 AM at the Cordillera Career Development College gym. Ramification, schedule and tournament formats and other concerns will be discussed by the tournament managers after the program.
11. An exhibition game in basketball men shall be played at CCDC between Capitol selection and DepEd selection after the opening program.
12. Expenses incurred in connection with the sports participation including meals and snacks during their games shall be borne by their respective delegations.
13. Service credits and COCs shall be granted to the participants and technical officials who rendered services on Saturdays and Sundays.
