Submission of Phil-IRI and CAR-IRI Pre and Post-test Results

- The Department of Education (DepEd) supports Every Child a Reader Program, which
 aims to make every Filipino child a reader and a writer at his/her grade level. Thus, the
 Schools Division of Benguet through the Curriculum Implementation Division shall
 continue to encourage schools to administer the Revised Philippine Informal Reading
 Inventory (Phil-IRI) assessment to learners in public elementary schools and the CARIRI for secondary schools in the division of Benguet.
- 2. The Phil-IRI and the CAR-IRI are used as a classroom-based assessment tool to measure and describe the learners' reading performance in both English and Filipino languages in oral reading, silent reading and listening comprehension. These three types of assessment aim to determine the learner's independent, instructional and frustration levels. It shall be administered to Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 for Phil-IRI Elementary Filipino and Grades 4, 5, and 6 for Phil-IRI English. CAR-IRI will only be administered to Grades 7, 8, and 9 in English.
- The Phil-IRI and CAR-IRI data shall also serve as one of the bases in planning, designing/redesigning the reading instruction of the teachers and the school's reading programs or activities to improve the overall school's reading performance.
- 4. Relative to this, all elementary schools shall submit the Phil-IRI pre and post-test results to the English and Filipino District Coordinators for consolidation and for submission to the division on or before July 8, 2022. Secondary Schools shall submit the CAR-IRI report on the reading program using the template as of March still on or before July 8, 2022.
