- As part of City Savings Bank and Weather Philippines Foundation's support to the disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation initiatives of the Department of Education, a Training Session on Weather 101 and Tropical Cyclone 101 will be held at the SDO Adivay Hall, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet on July 18, 2019.
