

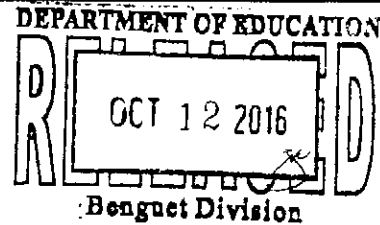

1. In pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, otherwise known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, Benguet-DepEd announces the conduct of the Division Training for teachers on Campus Journalism at the Cordillera Regional Science High School Hall on October 24-26, 2016.
2. This live-out training will enable the teachers to train their students write articles, publish school newspapers and organize Radio and Television Broadcasting teams.
3. Participants to this training are identified (New) Elementary school paper advisers and Junior high school paper advisers both public and private schools.
