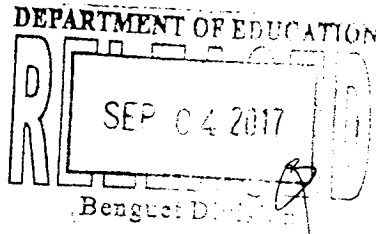

**SUBJECT: BENGUET TEACHERS DAY SPORTS COMPETITIONS AND IP GAMES**

1. In connection with the celebration of Benguet Teachers Day on September 29, 2017 as covered by Provincial Ordinance No. 15-170 series 2015, there will be a sports competition for teachers (as defined by the magna carta for teachers) and non-teaching personnel on September 9, 16, 17, 23 and 24, 2017.
2. Teachers' sports include volleyball, basketball, table tennis, billiards, chess and darts while non-teaching personnel sports is limited to volleyball men and women only. (see enclosures for more information)
3. Participants to this competition are teachers and non-teaching personnel from both public, private, SUC and other recognized schools in the province. Regular, LGU, and PTA paid teachers from the public schools are eligible to play except substitute teachers.
4. Indigenous Peoples games like: 4 X 50M relay, kadangkadang, tug-of-war, bunong braso and salikawkaw will be played at the Benguet Sports Center on September 27, 2017.
5. Submission of official entries of each team signed by their respective delegation heads/authorized official is at the Division Office to the Division Sports Coordinator on September 6, 2017 at 1:00 PM.
6. Expenses incurred including snacks and lunch and other incidental expenses of players shall be borne by their respective delegations or other sources of funds like PTA, MOOE and LGU
7. Service credits and COCs rendered on Saturdays and Sundays shall be granted to the participants, technical officials and members of the working committees.

## Enclosure 1

### General information and guidelines:

1. **For volleyball men and women and basketball men**, the team compositions are the following: One team each for BSU, Private HEI's, private elementary schools, private secondary schools and ATVIB/TESDA schools, a total of 5 teams. Public schools are clustered into 5 teams, elementary and secondary schools combined: Bakun, Kapangan and Kibungan- 1 team; Atok, Buguias and Mankayan-1 team; Bokod, Itogon and Kabayan- 1 team; Sablan, Tuba and Tublay- 1 team; and, La Trinidad- 1 team.
2. There shall be 12 players and one coach per team for the above games. Double elimination is used. Team uniform is required and bring your own balls.
3. **Volleyball men and women for non-teaching personnel** (SDO, School Officials, Heads and Staffs), the team compositions are the following: One team each for BSU, private HEIs, private elementary schools, private secondary schools and ATVIB/TESDA schools. Public elementary and secondary schools are regrouped into 2 teams: Bokod, Kabayan, Itogon, Sablan and Tuba- 1 team. Atok, Bakun, Buguias, Kapangan, Kibungan, La Trinidad, Mankayan and Tublay- 1 team. SDO personnel – 1 team. There shall be 12 players and a coach in a team. Team uniform is required and bring your own balls.
4. **For 9 ball billiards men and women, table tennis men and women, darts men and women, chess men and women; the team compositions are the following:** BSU-1 team, private HEI's- 1 team, private elementary schools- 1team, private secondary schools-1 team, ATVIB/TESDA schools-1 team; while the teams from the public elementary and secondary schools will follow their regular districts or a total of 14 districts. There shall be **one** entry per team. Knock out system is used. Players must bring their own equipment.
5. **For all IP games:** The composition of teams is the same as item No. 4 (for September 27).
  - A) Tug-of-war: each team is a combination of 5 men and 5 women. Men to wear bahag while women to wear tapis.
  - B) 4 X 50-meter relay: Each team is composed 4 men and 4 women respectively categorized into two; 36 years old and above and 35 years old and below. Men shall wear bahag and women to wear tapis.
  - C) 4 X 25 meter kadangkadang relay. This is the same as letter B above. Players must bring their own stilt.
  - D) Salikawkaw- for women. Each team is composed of 6 players. Attire - tapis.
  - E) Bunong Braso- 1 player per team. Attire – bahag.
6. The opening program to be participated in by all the teams mentioned above except IP Teams will be conducted at the CCDC Gym on September 9, 2017 at 8:30 AM. Free lunch will be served.
7. Basketball exhibition games will follow after the opening program:  
Game 1: Benguet Provincial Officials and staffs **versus** Private Schools NTP  
Game 2: Public and Private Colleges & Universities NTP **versus** Public DepEd Schools NTP.
8. A meeting of Technical Officials, tournament managers and team captains/coaches shall be conducted at the Adivay Hall, Schools Division Office on September 6, 2017 at 1:00 PM to discuss more on the details of the sports competitions.


