**DIVISION KICK-OFF FOR SY 2019-2020**

**Date:** July 17, 2019

1. Pursuant to Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 28, s. 2018 titled "Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd)," all public schools are encouraged to observe a nationwide **OK sa DepEd One Health Week** on the month of July.
2. This aimed to:
  - a. Promote learners and personnel health and nutrition practices that is embodied in the other flagship programs,
  - b. provide nursing, dental and medical services to learners and personnel,
  - c. collaborate closely to various partners and stakeholders, including other government agencies, private institutions, volunteer services of the community and families, and;
  - d. maximize opportunities for better and wider coverage of health service delivery.
3. Thus, the Schools Division of Benguet will be conducting this school year's Oplan Kalusugan (OK) sa DepEd One Health Week Division Kick-Off at **Loo Elementary School**, Buguias, Benguet on **July 29 – August 2, 2019**.
4. This is composed of an Advocacy and Celebration Program acknowledging partners and stakeholders of the school and then continuing with the week-long activities of the focusing on the 6 Flagship Programs of the School-based Health Programs. Activities are designed to minimize interruption of classes yet maximizing the opportunity to efficiently implement School-based Health Programs.
5. Consequently, all School Health Personnel are required to attend as facilitators in the week-long activities.
6. Travel expenses incurred in attendance to this meeting shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
