



SUBJECT: DIVISION NEEDS-BASED TRAINING IN TECHNOLOGY AND LIVELIHOOD EDUCATION (TLE) AND ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) TEACHERS IN GRADES 7-10

- 1. As part of its commitment to address the needs of teachers which were identified through Training Needs Assessment (TNA), the Schools Division Office of Benguet through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a limited face-to-face **Division Needs-Based Training for selected TLE** (Grades 7-10) and ALS teachers on June 23-25, 2022 at Eco Lodge, Magsaysay Avenue, Baguio City.
- 2. The activity aims to:
  - a. capacitate TLE and ALS teachers in grades 7-10 with necessary knowledge, skills and work values in the delivery and implementation of the TLE competencies in accordance with the thrust of the K-12 Curriculum;
  - b. gain knowledge and skills in developing Competency-Based Learning Materials (CBLM); and,
  - c. be able to develop/draft a learning module in TLE for Grades 7 to 10 learners.
- 3. Participants to the said training are the TLE and ALS Teachers in Grades 7 to 10 with National Certification Level I or 11 and without Trainers Methodology Certification. Number of participants per District and members of the Training Management Team is attached in Enclosure 1.
- 4. Participants are requested to bring their own laptop, pocket wifi, and soft-copy of their 2016 Curriculum Guide with the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs).
- 5. School heads and the Public School District Supervisors are requested to facilitate the identification of participants.
- 6. Lunch meals and snacks of participants for the three-day duration of the training shall be charged against the Human Resource Development Fund while their transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against available school or local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. A one-day Service Credit and Compensatory Time Off shall be granted to all the certified participants.

- 10. All participants must be fully vaccinated unless he/she is willing to undergo and present a negative Rapid Antigen Test on the first day of the training schedule.
