



#### MAKE:

- All Artworks size should be 2ft x 2ft or 24" x 24" on canvas, paper or wood.
- Artworks will be open to water-based medium and recycled materials.
  - 1. Acrylic on canvas, paper or wood.
  - 2. Watercolor, gouache and ink on paper.
  - 3. Collage, using old magazines or prints or any relevant materials.

#### **DEADLINE OF SUBMISSION:**

JUNE 30 2021, 12 midnight

#### **GUIDELINES:**

- 1. Fill up the Official ARTE-LIKHASAN ENTRY FORM.

- 2. Create your work following the theme specified and the Topics suggested
- 3. Once your work is completed, please sign your artwork for proper identification and authentication. Take a photo of the artwork with at least 3 different angles in the highest possible quality. You may also scan it if possible.
- 4. Email the photographs and/or scanned photo with your ENTRY FORM which includes your "artist statement" or inspirational remarks at <a href="mailto:earthdayjamfoundation@gmail.com">earthdayjamfoundation@gmail.com</a>.
