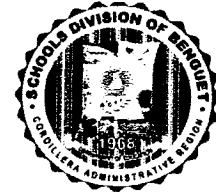

**Contest Rules and Criteria**

- ✓ The contest is open to all **Grade IV to VI** elementary pupils of Benguet, both public and Private.
- ✓ The poster shall be an Original creation of eligible participants, depicting the central theme of the World Food Day 2018 celebration, ***“Our Actions are our Future. A #Zero Hunger world by 2030 is possible.”***
- ✓ The canvas should be a **20”x30” illustration board**. The theme should be incorporated on the poster as part of its design. A poster with no indicated theme shall be disqualified.
- ✓ Theme should be hand written above the art work and should take up no more than two and a half inches (2.5”) for portrait and two inches (2”) for landscape.
- ✓ Description of the poster entry must be written at the back of the poster with the name of the student and coach, and the name of the school and district.
- ✓ Criteria for judging are as follows:

<i>A. Originality</i>	20%
<i>B. Creativity</i>	20%
<i>C. Visual Impact</i>	20%
<i>D. Relevance to the theme</i>	40%
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>100%</b>
