

FUTURE-READY IBENGUET LEARNERS PRIMING LIFE-READY SKILLS THROUGH TECHNOLOGY IN READING

TO: Chief Education Supervisors, SGOD and CID

All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office announces the conduct of the FIBER Professional Development Series 1 or Future-ready IBenguet learners priming life-ready skills through Technology in Reading on **July 25-28**, **2023**, at DepEd-CAR NEAP, Wangal, La Trinidad.
- 2. Specifically, the activity aims for the participants to:
 - a. Apply the knowledge and strategies gathered from learning about the Marungko and Fuller Approaches to teaching reading;
 - b. Share the knowledge and strategies gained with other teachers in their schools or districts through LAC sessions; and
 - c. Foster positive expectations among their learners as they apply the strategies in the teaching-learning process.
- 3. PSDSs and DCPs are requested to ask their respective School Heads to identify expected participants (5 Kindergarten teachers and 5 Grade 1 teachers per District). Preference is given to teachers without prior training in Beginning Reading and are committed to teach for at least 5 years in Kindergarten or Grade 1.
- 4. Attached in Enclosure 1 is the template for the identified participants and in Enclosure 2 is the Matrix Flow.
- 5. Meals (snacks and lunch) for the duration of the meeting shall be charged against Division HRTD funds while travel expenses of field participants shall be charged against available local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants who wish to lodge at the NEAP Dorm shall be entitled to breakfast and dinner provisions.
