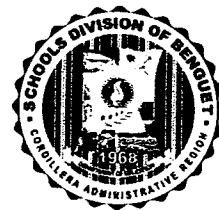

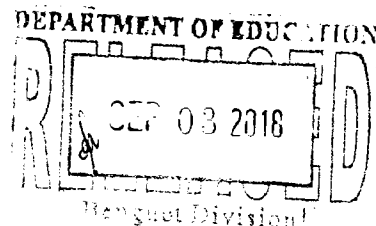



SUBJECT: ENHANCEMENT TRAINING ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM FOR SELECTED SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS

1. In line with the implementation of Republic Act 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Schools Division of Benguet in coordination with the Benguet School Paper Advisers' Association (BSPAA) will be conducting a three-day **Enhancement Training on Campus Journalism for Selected School Paper Advisers** on September 8-10, 2018 at the Eco Lodge, Magsaysay Avenue, Baguio City.
2. The participants to this training are selected school paper advisers from the identified elementary and secondary schools (see attached list) who have existing campus papers as per their active participation during the previous Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC).
3. At the end of the three-day training, the participants are expected to:
 - a. Gain updated knowledge and skills on the new trends in journalism such as online writing, column writing and TV and radio broadcasting;
 - b. Revisit and share their best practices in coaching and mentoring campus journalists in writing news, feature, editorial, sports and other journalism events; and
 - c. Come up with concrete plans and recommendations on how to improve the quality of campus papers in their respective schools.
4. The teacher participants are expected to prepare appropriate class activities during the school day of the seminar to ensure that students will still be engaged on time on task as per existing issuances.
5. The three lunch meals and six snacks of participants during the three-day activity including the lodging of six resource speakers for one (1) day shall be charged from the Division HRTD fund. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local fund/school MOOE subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
6. To augment the expenses for the Day 2 and Day 3 board and lodging of six resource speakers from Manila including their transportation allowance and tokens, the BSPAA shall be collecting a counterpart contribution of P400.00 per participant to be chargeable exclusively against School Journalism fund.
7. Participants are entitled for a two-day service credits/COC during the seminar.
8. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
