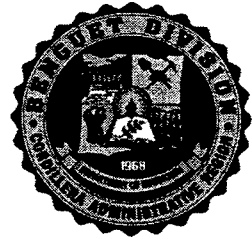

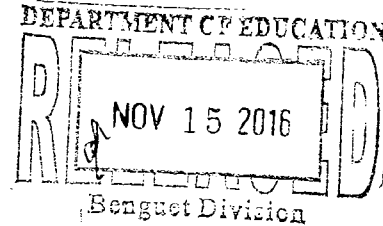

Guidelines and Mechanics for the Drum and Lyre Competition

1. Participants

- Participants shall be eighty (80) elementary pupils duly enrolled for this current school year and five (5) coaches/trainers/assistants.
- List of participants which includes name and grade level, certified by the school head shall be submitted. Names of coaches/trainers/assistants shall be included in the list
- Participants shall come from the following districts: Bokod - 1 slot; Itogon 1 - 1 slots; Itogon 2 - 1 slots; Kibungan - 1 slots; La Trinidad - 3 slots; Mankayan - 1 slot; Sablan - 1 slot; Tuba - 2 slots; Tublay - 1 slot; Buguias - 1 slot.

2. Assembly

- Delegates shall assemble at 8:00 at their designated areas on the contest day. The program shall start at 8:30 AM. The designated areas shall be determined according to the sequence of the performances which shall be drawn by lots.

3. Time Limit

- Each performance is given a maximum time of seven (7) minutes and maximum time of ten (10) minutes including the entrance and exit.
- Time starts when the green flag is raised and whistle is blown.
- Yellow flag shall be raised one (1) minute before the time limit.
- Time ends when the red flag is raised.
- Performances exceeding ten (10) minutes shall be deducted 0.5 point for every one minute excess.

4. Entrance and Exit

- There shall be only one entrance and one exit for all participants

5. Announcement of Winners

- Winners shall be announced just after the competition


6. Judges' Decision

- The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable


Criteria for Judging Drum and Lyre Competition

1	Musicality (melody, rhythm, harmony, tempo, texture, dynamics)	35%
2	Coordination (mastery of the performance and synchronization of movements)	30%
3	Choreography (creativity, relevance to the theme and interpretation)	20%
4	Costumes and props (appropriateness and depict floral theme)	10%
5	Entrance and Exit	5%
