SUBJECT: 2019 BENGUET TEACHERS DAY SPORTS AND INDIGENOUS PEOPLES GAMES COMPETITION

- 1. Prior to the conduct of the Benguet Teachers' Day Celebration on September 27, 2019, there will be a sports competition for teachers in basketball men, volleyball men & women, table tennis men & women, billiards men & women, badminton men & women, darts men & women and chess men & women.
- 2. Participants to this competition are the teachers (as defined in the Magna Carta for Teachers which include Guidance Counselors, Nurses, Administrative Officers and other Non-Teaching Personnel). LGU, PTA paid and substitute teachers are eligible to play as long as they are on active duty. However, the DepEd policy on non-suspension of classes must be observed.
- 3. Each team in all events must prepare a duly accomplished gallery of players signed by their respective officials to be submitted on or before August 10, 2019 to the Tournament Managers (see enclosure 1).
- 4. Required number of players shall follow what was agreed during the Sports Officials' meeting on July 25, 2019 (See enclosure 2).
- 5. Elimination rounds shall be played in their respective divisions grouped as: 1. DepEd-Elementary Division 2. DepEd-Secondary Division 3. Private Elementary Division 4. Private Secondary Division 5. State College and University 6. Private HEIs and 7. Tech-Voc/ATVIB/TESDA to come up with the 7 above mentioned teams (see enclosure 3).
- 6. All teams are asked to bring their own equipment/implement like basketball balls, volleyball net & balls and shuttle cocks. Uniform is mandatory in basketball, volleyball and other team games most especially the jersey/t-shirt.
- 7. IP contest/games are Pinikpikan, Palay Pounding, Kadangkadang Men & Women, Tugof-War Men & Women, Yakyak-ing Women and Bunong Braso Men & Women will be played on September 26, 2019 at the Benguet Sports Center (see enclosure no. 2). Criteria for pinikpikan and palay pounding contest will be issued later.
- 8. All players of the 7 teams above except IP games are asked to attend the opening program on August 10, 2019 at 9:00 at the Kings College of the Philippines. Schedule of games and tournament formats and other concerns will be discussed after the program.
- 9. A lunchatwo snacks will be provided during the opening program charged to Division MOOE. While travel expenses incurred by the participants may be charged to local funds and or other fund sources.
- 10. Service credits and COCs shall be granted to DepEd participants and technical officials for Saturdays, Sundays & Holiday activities in connection with Teachers' Sports.
