

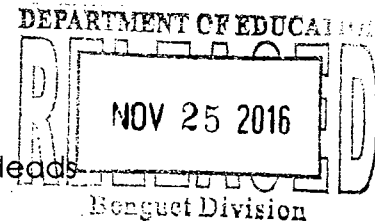

**DIVISION PRESENTATION AND VALIDATION OF CONTEXTUALIZED
GRADE 7 CURRICULUM**

1. As an offshoot of the recently concluded training writeshop on contextualizing the curriculum for Indigenous Peoples Education-IPEd, the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) Provincial Office in coordination with the Schools Division of Benguet will conduct the presentation and validation of Contextualized Grade 7 Curriculum at Rajah Soliman Hotel and Restaurant, Bokawkan Road, Baguio City on December 2-3, 2016. This is a live-out conference.

The activity aims to present the contextualized curriculum for Grade 7 and Indigenized Lesson Plans in all subject areas for final validation by community elders, stakeholders and division curriculum writers and for quality assurance by learning area supervisors to ensure its effectivity and efficiency.

3. **All Teacher trained facilitators and the curriculum writers per learning area are requested to submit their four (4) or more indigenized lesson plans (to be placed in brown envelope with label) to this office on or before December 1, 2016 for initial critiquing.**


