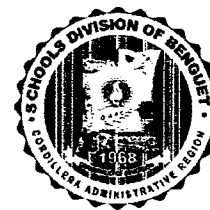

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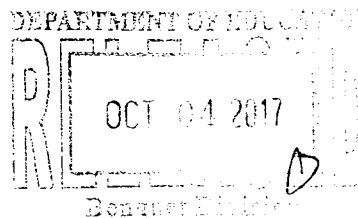

Subject: **DIVISION SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL QUIZ BEE IN CELEBRATION OF THE 28TH NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH CELEBRATION**

1. Pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2017-12 issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) and the Presidential Proclamation No. 647, "Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as the National Statistics Month", the Schools Division enjoins and strongly supports the 28th National Statistics Month Celebration.
2. In line with the celebration, the Schools Division will be conducting its second year Statistics Quiz Bee with the theme: "Facts and Figures for the Future: Statistics for Evidence-Based Decisions Towards AmBisyonNatin 2040".
3. The activity aligns its objective to the National Statistics Month whereby it aims to promote, enhance, and instill nationwide awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of the society; and elicit the cooperation and support of the general public in upgrading the quality and standards of statistics in the country.
4. One (1) contestant will come from each Senior High School having a total of forty five (45) learners to be accompanied by one (1) coach per district to complete the fifty nine (59) over-all expected participants.
5. The Division Statistics Quiz Bee which will be held at the Adivay Conference Hall on October 24, 2017 from 8:00 am to 12 noon (enclosure 1).
6. The first place winner will receive a certificate and will be representing the Division in the Regional Statistics Quiz Bee. Certificates will also be given to all learners and coaches as participants.
7. Guidelines and mechanics for the said Statistics Quiz is adopted from the 2016 Regional Statistics Quiz for Public Secondary Students conducted at the Regional Office (enclosure 2).
8. Morning snacks will be provided, while transportation and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

GUIDELINES/MECHANICS OF THE REGIONAL STATISTICS QUIZ

1. Substitution is not allowed during the Quiz proper.
2. No cellphones, tablets, or any other electronic communication devices are allowed during the competition.
3. There will be three (3) components in the competition: Easy Round, Average Round and Difficult Round.
4. Questions will include general information, basic educational statistics and general statistics.
5. Each question will have the following sequence:
 - a. The quiz master will read the question projected on the screen twice. A timer will start after the quiz master says "GO".
 - b. Each team will raise their answer card after the quiz master will say "TIME IS UP" until the scores are properly recorded.
 - c. The quiz master will announce the correct answer for the questions. The assigned proctors will check each team's answer card to determine if their answer is correct or wrong. The proctor will raise a BLUE flag for a correct answer and a RED flag for a wrong or no answer at all.
6. In case of a tie, tie-breaker questions will be given until a winner is determined by the highest number of points. Each tie-breaker question will be given four (4) points.
7. Decisions of the Quiz Committee shall be final and non-appealable.

EASY ROUND:

1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth two (2) points for each question.
2. Each question is timed for ten (10) seconds.
3. The scores of each team will be totalled and carried over to the next round.

MODERATE ROUND:

1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth (3) points for each question.
2. Each question is timed for twenty (20) seconds.
3. The scores of each team will be totalled and carried over to the next round.

DIFFICULT ROUND:

1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth five (5) points for each question.
2. Each question is timed for thirty (30) seconds.
5. At the end of the Difficult Round, all scores will be summed up and the top three teams will be declared as the winners. The team with the highest number of points is automatically declared as the champion and the next teams as runner ups.
