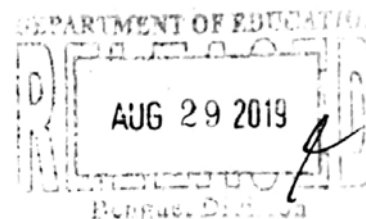

**Subject:** Cybersafety in Schools Training

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 94, s. 2016 on “Promotion of Online Child Protection and Prevention of Cyberbullying,” the Department of Education (DepEd) advocates for the protection of all children from online abuse, exploitation, and bullying through the use of the Cybersafety Lesson Plans for Grades One to Four, Grades Five to Six, and Junior High School. Developed through the partnership of DepEd and Stairway Foundation, Inc. (SFI), the lesson plans aim to develop children’s capacities on how to be safe online, teach positive online behavior, and address safety issues as they navigate the online world.
2. To further the advocacy, the DepEd and SFI designed a training program for teachers and Division Personnel on the use of the Cybersafety Lesson Plans which will be held from September 16 – 20, 2019 in Baguio City. The venue will be announced in a subsequent memorandum.

Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 94, s. 2016 on "Promotion of Online Child Protection and Prevention of Cyberbullying", the Department of Education (DepEd) advocates for the protection of all children from online abuse, exploitation, and bullying through the use of the Cybersafety Lesson Plans for Grades One to Four, Grades Five to Six, and Junior High School. Developed through the partnership of DepEd and Stairway Foundation, Inc. (SFI), the lesson plans aim to develop children's capacities on how to be safe online, teach positive online behavior, and address safety issues as they navigate the online world.

To further the advocacy, the DepEd and SFI designed a training program for teachers and Division personnel on the use of the Cybersafety Lesson Plans.

Thus, the **Cybersafety in Schools Training** for Batch Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) will be conducted on September 16-20, 2019 in Baguio City. The venue will be announced in a subsequent Memorandum.

Participants to this training shall come from the Regional Office and all Division Offices of CAR. The composition is as follows:

- From every Division:
  - One (1) DepEd personnel from the School Governance and Operations Division, specifically, the person-in-charge of Human Resources;
  - Three (3) Elementary School Master Teacher on *Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao*; and
  - Three (3) Secondary School Master Teacher on *Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao*.


- Four (4) Regional Office personnel from the following units:
  - Education Support Services Division;
  - Curriculum Implementation Division; and
  - Other concerned offices.

Participants who have successfully completed the training shall be designated as **Trainers on Cybersafety** and are expected to cascade what they learned from the training to their respective Divisions. Thus, we request that the Division select participants who are familiar with the Internet and social media and have the expertise and leadership skills to train other school and Division personnel. Selected participants should also have a background or prior knowledge of the Child Protection policies and protocols of the Department.

All concerned are requested to submit the names of their participants on or before **August 30, 2019** using the attached Confirmation Slip through email at [childprotection@deped.gov.ph](mailto:childprotection@deped.gov.ph).

All participants' travel and incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
