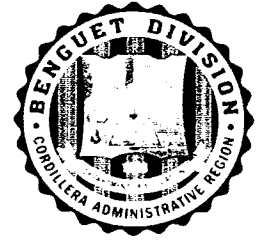

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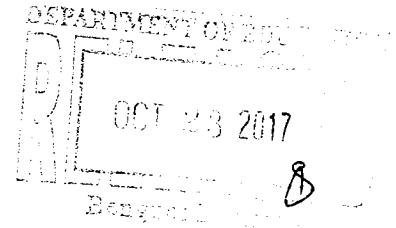

Subject: 2017 Division Festival of Talents-Technolympics

1. SDO Benguet shall conduct the 2017 Division Technolympics with the theme "Enriching Skills, Transforming Lives" on November 21-23, 2017 at Tublay School of Home Industries (TSHI), Tublay, Benguet.
2. The events will provide opportunities for students to showcase their performance in various skills acquired by our students in their respective specializations in Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP), Technology & Livelihood Education (TLE) and Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL) Senior High School Track.
3. The first place winners in the District Level Technolympics shall be the participants to the division level contest.
4. List of Official District Delegation to the Division Level Technolympics shall be submitted to Benguet Division Office on or before November 13, 2017 to be coordinated to the host school venue in three (3) copies.
5. All Coaches and Contestants are required to submit the following documents at the Division Office through their District Supervisors on or before November 13, 2017.
 - a. For Contestants
 - Certification by the head that the participant/s is/are bonafide student/s enrolled in public / private elementary, general secondary or Technical-Vocational School/SUC during the school year 2016-2017.
 - Certification of the school head that the students are enrolled in the field of specialization where they are competing and participating,
 - Photocopied School I.D.
 - Form 137 with 2 x 2 picture attached, and
 - b. For Coaches
 - Certification from the Principal that the teacher is a bonafide staff of the school being represented,

- Certification from the Principal of the Teacher's designation as the adviser / coach of the student participant,
 - Service record, and
 - Photocopied School I.D.
- c. The requirements shall be placed in a short brown envelope. On the upper right hand part of the envelope (the side without the flap) write the name of the School, district, and /or University indicated, name of contestant/s and name of the coach.
6. Participants to the Skills Competition shall be on Official business.
 7. Registration fee for each elementary and secondary participant and coach is **Eight hundred pesos (800.00)** to cover the expenses for board and lodging, Trophies, Certificates, and other incidental and operational expenses ,chargeable against local funds and other available sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
 8. Arrival of the participants will be at 1:00 P.M. of November 21, 2017. First meal will be dinner of the same day and last meal will be dinner of November 23, 2017. Upon arrival, participants shall proceed to the Registration In-Charge for registration. After registration, Official receipt and Meal Ticket in the name of the host school –shall be given to be presented to the billeting in-charge.
 9. No participant/s is allowed to register after the technolympics duration and to participate in the skill competition without registration.
 10. All participants are required to bring their own beddings, enough clothing for the duration and medicine. Food will be catered. Likewise, participants are expected to bring their contest supplies, materials, tools/equipment, except those that are to be provided by the host school as agreed during the Planning Conference last September 26, 2017.
 11. Each district delegation shall bring their Banner and uniform.
 12. All Officers, School Head Coordinators of Technolympics, elementary and secondary participants and Contest Administrators are required to attend the solidarity meeting at 2:00 P.M. onward November 2017. Attendance is to be checked.
 13. Other details and concerns shall be discussed during the Solidarity meeting on November 21, 2017. Questions shall only be entertained during the said meeting.
