# ASEAN MONTH CELEBRATION ACTIVITIES

- 1. In line with Regional Memorandum No. 508, s. 2024, the Schools Division of Benguet through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the **Division Poster Making Contest and Quiz Bee on ASEAN Issues** on August 24, 2024 at the Adivay Hall, SDO Benguet, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet as part of the activities for the commemoration of the founding anniversary of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) as per Presidential Proclamation No. 282 dated July 31, 2018 declaring August as ASEAN Month.
- 2. Bearing the theme, "ASEAN: Enhancing Connectivity and Resilience," the activities aim to:
  - a. expose learners to ASEAN cultural, political, and social information;
  - b. foster the spirit of healthy competition among ASEAN youth,
  - c. recognize the creative artistry of Filipino learners; and
  - d. provide an avenue to hone the critical thinking skills of learners.
- 3. The poster contests involved two categories as follows: Category A for learners under Key Stage 1 (Grades 4-6) and Category B for learners either from Key Stage 3 (Grades 7-10) or Key Stage 4 (Grades 11-12). On the other hand, the ASEAN Quiz Bee shall be for Grade 9 or Grade 10 learners.
- 4. The specific mechanics of the contests are found in the enclosure of this memorandum.
- 5. The participants in this division-level competition are the first-place winners from each of the 14 districts and their respective teacher coaches together with the district coordinators

- 6. The first-place winners and their respective coaches in each of the contested events shall represent Benguet during the Regional ASEAN Activities on August 30, 2024, at the DepEd CAR Regional Office.
- 7. The winners in the contested events shall receive certificates and cash prizes as follows:

First Place P3,000.00 Second Place P2,000.00 P1,000.00 Third Place Consolation Prizes P 500.00



Guidelines for the ASEAN Month Celebration Contests

#### **ASEAN QUIZ**

The student participants in the Division Level Quiz Bee must:

- a. be in Grades 9 or 10, between 15-17 years old;
- b. come from either a public or private school;
- c. be proficient in the English Language, both oral and written;
- d. have an average grade of 85 and above in Araling Panlipunan during the SY 2023-2024;
- e. have good interpersonal skills; and
- f. meet other criteria that may deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee

# **GUIDELINES ON THE QUIZ BEE:**

A. The 14 contestants from the 14 districts shall compete individually in two segments as follows:

- 1. True or False and Multiple Choice
- 2. Fill in the blank or completion
- B. Segment 1: The TRUE or FALSE part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given one (1) point. The multiple-choice part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer is given one (1) point. The total score is 20 points. Participants are given 10 seconds to write their answers in each item.
- C. Segment 2: Fill in the Blanks or Completion will have 20 questions. Each correct answer will be given three (3) points. The total score is 60 points. Participants are given 15 seconds to write their answers in each item. A buzzer/bell shall indicate that time is up. Answers should be written in full with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be correct. Answers with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants, but the previous answers must be fully erased or fully crossed out within the prescribed time limit.
- D. The total score for the competition is 80 points.

- E. Each participant is advised to bring 1/4 whiteboard, marker, and eraser to write answers.
- F. Each question for segment 1 and 2 shall be read twice. After the Quizmaster reads the question the second time, he/she will say "GO," only then will the participants write their answers. When the time is up, the Quizmaster will say "Marker's Up," participants will hold their markers up and their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answers of each participant. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the Quizmaster after each round before going on to the next segment.
- G. Should there be questions or protests, the Board of Judges shall decide on the matter. Their decision is final.
- H. The chairman shall declare the winner/s.

#### B. POSTER-MAKING CONTEST Event Rules and Mechanics

- 1. There will be two categories for the poster-making contest.
  - a. Category A: Elementary Level from Key Stage 2 (Grade 4-6)
  - b. Category B. High School Level category from either Key Stage 3 (Grade 7-10) or Key Stage 4 (Grade 11-12)
- The Poster-making is an on-the-spot event.
- 3. Entries should follow the theme: "ASEAN: Enhancing Connectivity and Resilience
- 4. Only one (1) learner-participant per category from each to District join.
- 5. Learner participants are given four (4) hours to finish their output.
- 6. Participants may use oil pastels, crayons, or watercolors as a medium for poster-making.
- 7. Participants are not allowed to bring pictures or images as references to their entries.
- 8. Participants must come on time. However, late participants shall still be accommodated but time shall not be extended.

#### Criteria for Judging

Criteria	Percentage
Artistic Merit	25%
(Elements and Principles of Art)	
Interpretation of the theme (Relevance)	40%
Difficulty (Technique)	15%
Overall impression of the art (Artwork on its own as a complete and outstanding work of art)	20%
