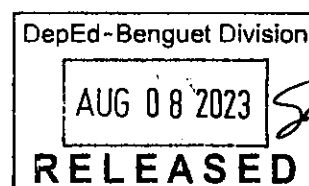

**DIVISION TRAINING OF TEACHERS ON EARLY LANGUAGE, LITERACY
AND NUMERACY (ELLN) WITH FOCUS ON THE SCIENCE OF READING**

To: Chief Education Supervisors of CID and SGOD

1. The Schools Division of Benguet through the Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct the Division Training of teachers on Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy (ELLN) with Focus on the Science of Reading on August 13 to 16, 2023 at Paradiso Beach Resort, Aringay , La Union.
2. The activity aims to
 - a. roll out training in Early Language Literacy and Numeracy focusing on the Science of Reading
 - b. promote and sustain a culture of reading in schools and even in the communities.
 - c. level reading materials; and
 - d. review Marungko as an approach in reading.
3. Attach with this Memorandum are the List of Participants and Training Matrix found in Enclosures 1 and 2 respectively.
4. The expected arrival of participants at the venue will be on August 13 in the morning. The first meal to be served is PM snacks on Day 1 (August 13) and last meal is lunch of Day 3 (August 16). The opening program shall begin at 1:00 PM on August 13.
5. Participants shall be teachers of K to 6 who did not attend any training on teaching beginning reading and early grades literacy instruction. Also, teachers who are newly hired and who are assigned in the K to 3 classes. Teachers in Grades 4 and 6 shall also be considered.





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6. Participants are required to bring a photocopy of reading materials for levelling. (Grades 1 to 3 at least 5 reading text, Grades 4 to 6 =15 reading text)
7. Travel expenses and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against available local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants are encouraged to avail of the most economical means of transport in going to and from the venue.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
