

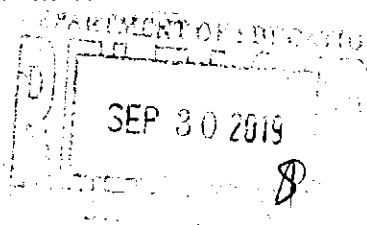

**Subject:** 2019 Division Filipino Values Month Celebration

**Date:** September 24, 2019

1. Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 7, 1994 and DepEd Memorandum No. 177, s. 2018 stipulate that the Filipino Values Month is celebrated every November of each year as a way to manifest and advocate the core Filipino values of Maka Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa.
2. Relative to the above issuances, the Schools Division of Benguet through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct Division Festival of Talents in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) as one of the activities to celebrate this year Filipino Values Month.
3. The Division Festival of Talents on EsP will be held on November 15, 2019 at the SDO, Adivay Hall with the theme "Pagpapanumbalik at Pagpapatibay ng Kagandahang Asal: Hamon ng Milenyong Panahon"
4. This aims to provide learners with equal opportunities to discover, develop and display their talents and skills in EsP and provide learning avenues for learners and teachers to enhance their skills in their field of interest.
5. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds or other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Enclosed are the mechanics of the different contested activities for information and guidance of all concerned.

## **GUIDELINES FOR ESP Festival of Talents**

**November 15, 2019 at SDO, Adivay Hall**

**Theme: Pagpapanumbalik at Pagpapatibay ng Kagandahang Asal: Hamon ng Milenyong Panahon**

1. The contestants must be bonafide pupils/students of Benguet schools for the current school year. Their names and grade levels with the name of their trainers/coaches should be signed by their school head and to be submitted to the Schools Division Office on September 11, 2019.
2. Participants to this activity are the first place winners from each district in the different contested activities: Tagis -Talino, Sayawit and On- the -Spot Poster Making of both elementary and secondary level.
3. **A. Tagis - Talino ( Elementary and Secondary)**
  1. It will be a team event composed of three members from the different grade levels (Grades 4-6 for Elementary and Grades 7-10 for Secondary).
  2. The team will compete in the Easy ( 1 point), Average (3 points) and Difficult (5 points ) categories.
  3. There will be ten questions per category that relate to the content of EsP Grades 4,5, 6 for Elementary and Grades 7, 8, 9, 10 for Secondary.
  4. The quizmaster will read the questions twice and the team will be given 5 seconds to write their answers on the answer sheet then wait for the quizmaster's signal to raise their answer . The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
  5. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners. (Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner –up respectively.)
  6. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask a new set of three questions. The team with the highest score will automatically be declared as the winner.
    - For the questions each participating district will prepare 5 questions per category coming from the contents of ESP grades 4-6 for elementary and EsP grades 7-10 for the secondary. It should be encoded using font size 12 and Time New Romans font style in an A4 size bondpaper and in a portrait orientation. Three questions will be placed on one(1) bond paper. The answer to the question should be written below side by side with the competency code. The submission of the questions to the Division Office will be a day before the contest proper or on November 14, 2019.

**B. Sayawit ( Elementary and Secondary)**

1. The group must be composed of 7-10 members, coming from grades 4-6 (Elementary) and from Grades 7-10 (Secondary).
2. Presentation time should be 8-10 minutes . A minute is given to the group for the preparation and one(1) point deduction from the overall score will be given to the group that will exceed from the allotted time of presentation.
3. Live accompaniment is required and no lip-synchs.
4. Costumes and props must be appropriate for the movements.
5. Criteria for judging:

a. Concept and relevance to the theme	30%
b. Choreography	25%
c. Musicality	25%
d. Props and Costumes	10%
e. Over-all staging impact	<u>10%</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>100%</b>

**C. On- the – Spot Poster Making ( Elementary and Secondary)**

1. There will only be one (1) participant per district coming from any grade ( 4 -6) from the Elementary and one (1) participant coming from any grade (7-10) from the Secondary.
2. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials: ¼ illustration board,pencil and pastel/craypass.
3. The contestants are given three hours to finish their work.
4. Letterings and borders are not part of the presentation.
5. Criteria for judging:

a. Relevance to the theme	30%
b. Creativity	25%
c. Originality	25%
d. Visual Impact	<u>10%</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>100%</b>
