

NOMINATION AND SELECTION OF OUTSTANDING PUBLIC-SCHOOL TEACHERS FOR RECOGNITION DURING THE BENGUET TEACHERS' DAY

- 1. In line with Provincial Ordinance No.15-170 declaring the last Friday of September as Teachers' Day in the Province of Benguet, the Benguet Teachers' Day Council recommended the nomination and selection of Outstanding Teachers from the public schools, private learning institutions, technical-vocational institutes, and higher education institutions to be recognized during the province's Teachers' Day major celebration on September 29, 2023.
- 2. The search for Outstanding Teachers from public schools seeks to recognize teachers whose efforts and initiatives contributed to learning recovery, improved learning conditions, and other significant changes with impacts on the lives of learners.
- 3. Considering the relevance of the occasion in giving tributes to the teachers, this search aims to uplift their morale and provide them with positive motivation as they continue to create favorable conditions for effective learning to happen.
- 4. The specific mechanics and guidelines for the nomination and selection of outstanding teachers from public schools in each district are found in Enclosure 1.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is enjoined.

Enclosure 1: Guidelines on the Nomination for Outstanding Teacher Award 2023

- 1. The Outstanding Teacher Award during the observance of the 2023 National Teachers' Month aims to recognize and honor teachers who did something worthwhile for the learners and the community without having to submit documentary requirements. Many teachers have gone the extra mile of extending sincere service or coming up with several initiatives to uplift the situation of learners but were not previously recognized due to documentary requirements. This is their opportunity to be given recognition, if possible.
- 2. A school head or a teacher-colleague may nominate a teacher for the Outstanding Teacher Award with an accompanying one to two-page write-up describing why the teacher is being nominated. Such write-up would be the basis for the plaque of recognition in case said nominee would be selected. This is to be submitted to the District PRAISE Committee within the period from August 24-25, 2023.
- 3. Each District PRAISE Committee shall select one (1) Outstanding Teacher from the submitted nominations.
- 4. All of the selected fourteen (14) district outstanding teachers will eventually be the 14 Outstanding Teachers during the 2023 National Teachers' Month. The awarding ceremonies will be conducted on September 29, 2023, during the Benguet Teachers' Day culminating program.
- 5. The nomination and selection at the district level shall be from August 18 -25, 2023. The Outstanding Teacher's complete name, position, and school from each district shall be submitted on or before August 25, 2023 through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) office. The accompanying brief nomination write-up containing the worthwhile initiatives and accomplishments of the nominee shall be submitted to the Schools Division Office through the CID on or before September 6, 2023.
