


Subject: **CONDUCT OF THE 2019 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS-TECHNOLYMPICS**

Date: **October 1, 2019**

1. The 2019 Division Festival of Talents-Technolympics bearing the theme: "Celebrating Diversity through the Performance of Talents and Skills for Sustainable Inclusive Education", will be conducted at Tublay School of Home Industries, Acop, Tublay, Benguet on October 29-31, 2019.
2. Each district shall conduct its District skills competition involving public and private schools including ALS learners (for secondary skills only) to select its division entries in all the contested areas.
3. All the first place winners in the District Level Technolympics shall be the participants to the division level contest.
4. A registration fee of P800.00 per participant shall be collected to cover expenses for catered meals and snacks for three days, honoraria of judges and other incidental expenses, chargeable against local fund/school MOOE subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
5. The specific guidelines and mechanics for the conduct of the skills competition and contest packages to be competed up to the national level are found in the enclosures.
6. All participants are required to bring their own beddings and enough clothing for the duration of the activity. Likewise, participants are expected to bring their contest supplies, materials, tools/equipment, except those that are to be provided by the host school as agreed during the Planning Conference on August 23, 2019.
7. As per agreement, the over-all standing of districts will be determined via point system.
8. Each district will select one best Strategic Intervention Materials (SIM) and one best research proposal in EPP/TLE for elementary and one for the secondary teachers to be judged prior to the competition proper. Deadline of submission will be on October 17, 2019 at the SDO-Benguet.

9. Arrival of the participants will be at 1:00 P.M. of October 29, 2019. All Officers, Coordinators of Technolympics elementary and secondary participants, Contest Administrators are required to attend the solidarity meeting at 2:00 P.M. onward. Attendance are to be checked.

10. Other details and concerns shall be discussed during the Solidarity meeting. Question shall only be entertained during the said meeting.

11. Each district delegation shall bring their district banners and uniform.

12. Moreover, a one-day planning conference to all the officers and district coordinators from both elementary and secondary to finalize the rubrics, contest packages of the skills and other matters pertinent to the conduct of the Division technolympics on October 10, 2018 at TSHI, Acop, Tublay, Benguet. The participants shall be granted one-day Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) for non-teaching and service credit for teachers. Travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
