Subject: **CLINIQUING/COACHING OF BENGUET PARTICIPANTS TO THE REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE**

1. In final preparation for the participation of Benguet to the 2018 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC), there will be a **one-day cliniquing/coaching** of qualified participants to the said regional journalism event on December 1, 2018 which will start at 8:00 o'clock A.M. at the La Trinidad Central School, Poblacion, La Trinidad, Benguet.
2. The participants to this activity are the top 5 winners of the different individual events in English and Filipino in the elementary and secondary levels during the recent Division Schools Press Conference and the top 1 winners in the different team events in both mediums and levels. The winning coaches shall accompany their pupils/students as they will be having meeting at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon to discuss the specific details of the participation of Benguet to the RSPC.
3. Participants to the individual events are expected to bring their ballpens, pencils, notebook and the like during the activity. School Paper Advisers shall make sure that the students secure parents' consent to join the cliniquing and the upcoming RSPC 2018.
4. Transportation and food expenses of participants and coaches shall be charged to local funds/school journalism fund while the honoraria of speakers/facilitators and their lunch and snacks shall be charged to the Benguet School Paper Advisers' Association (BSPAA) subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.
